- On recording days, assist with directing the performers and supporting the Artistic Directors
- Review marketing materials in Turkish and feedback to the UK team
- Be the UK representative when discussing the Turkish language version with our partners.

The consultant will have experience working in a directing or adaptation capacity within the arts or immersive work and will be a Turkish native living in London, fluent in Turkish.
