

# Focus on Recognition of Key Words

## **Pictionary:**

### **Materials:**

- Large paper pad
- list of significant words on cards (printed from list provided)
- sharpie
- Compass text

### **Procedure:**

- Divide into two fair teams and show the first person on each team the key word on a card.
- Teams can use the large pad or they can use paper at their tables to draw the word.
- Whichever team is the first to guess, wins that round.
- Continue until all the words are used or time runs out.
- The team with the most points wins.

The word needs to be drawable. Example, "sanctify" is not drawable, but "clean" is drawable. Younger groups could be given hints after a minute of drawing and no one has guessed the word.
