**COSTS:**

- **Combined training (*Test A both days*) - \$55 per Test - includes dressage test and jumping test. Low score wins.**
- **Dressage only: \$25 per entry.**
- **Jump Competition: \$35 per entry.**
- **Schooling jump round only: \$25 per round.**
- **STABLING IS MANDATORY, NO WORKING OUT OF TRAILER: \$25 day stall or \$30 overnight, includes first bedding, separate check payable to Donida Farm. You must clean your stall when you leave. Separate \$30 stall cleaning deposit fee, made out to Area VII Adult Riders. Stalls will be inspected and if you have cleaned your stall, your check will be destroyed. Stall fee to Donida Farm and the \$30 deposit to AR are required in advance.**

1. **INTRO Beginning Novice** - Jumping Course: 12" - 24", approx. Speed 250 mpm.  
**Class 1a** – Intro Combined training/BN dressage test & Intro jump round \$55  
**Class 1b** – Intro BN Jump (Competition) \$35 per round  
**Class 1c** – Intro BN Jump (additional jump round). \$25 per round
  
2. **Beginner Novice** - Jumping course: to 2' 7", approx. Speed 300 mpm.  
**Class 2a** – BN Combined training/Dressage test & jump round \$55  
**Class 2b** – BN Dressage only \$25  
**Class 2c** – BN Jump (Competition) \$35 per round  
**Class 2d** – BN Jump (additional round) \$25 per round
  
3. **Novice** - Jumping course 2' 11", approx. Speed 325 mpm.  
**Class 3a** – Novice Combined Training/Dressage test & jump round \$55  
**Class 3b** – Novice Dressage only \$25  
**Class 3c** – Novice Jump (Competition) \$35 per round  
**Class 3d** – Novice Jump (additional round) \$25 per round
  
4. **Training** - Jumping course: 3' 3", approx. Speed 350 mpm.  
**Class 4a** – Training Combined Test/Dressage test & jump round \$55  
**Class 4b** – Training Dressage only \$25  
**Class 4c** – Training Jump (Competition) \$35 per round  
**Class 4d** – Training Jump (additional round) \$25 per round
  
5. **Preliminary** - Jumping course: 3' 7", approx. Speed 375 mpm.  
**Class 5a** – Preliminary Combined Training/Dressage test & jump round \$55  
**Class 5b** – Preliminary Dressage only \$25  
**Class 5c** – Preliminary Jump (Competition) \$35 per round  
**Class 5b** – Preliminary Jump (additional round) \$25 per round

**Combined training and/or Dressage only,** 2018 USEA A test A both days. You may enter more than one dressage test and level.

- Competitors are encouraged to enter more than one division.
- All dressage tests ridden in a small court.
- Additional schooling jumping rounds may be post-entered and are encouraged if time/space allows. Post entries will need to be ready to ride when the respective division is open. *(We will try to accommodate all post entries but this may or may not be possible depending on the number of entries).*
- Eventing Rules will be followed.
- Casual Attire: Shirts with collars, breeches, boots and helmets w/ chinstrap. Medical armbands should be worn when jumping.
- Refunds: Before closing date, less \$30 office fee. **No refunds after closing date of 3/13/18.** If you need to scratch please email the secretary.

- We will be starting in the morning at 8:00 am.
- If the show must be rescheduled, a notice will be posted to the website before 8:00 pm 3/15/18.

**To ensure your entry is accepted, please be sure your entry is complete (includes all required forms and payments) as complete entries will take priority.**

All riders must wear an approved helmet when mounted at all times and must have checked into the office and received their bridle tag number for their horse before entering the competition arenas. All riders must sign a Donida Farm release and an USEA release before riding on the property.

Extra/non competing horses are welcome but must pay the \$10 grounds fee and the rider must have signed a release prior to riding.

# Donida Farm Competitor Rules

- Main barn/arena area for "load and unload" only.
- Park horse trailers in designated trailer parking area only.
- Spectator parking in designated parking only.
- Keep fire lanes open at all times. Between C and B barns and Between D and Donida Shop.
- Campground use includes fire pit .and showers. Please extinguish fires before retiring.
- No Haul-in horses allowed. Horse must be stalled.
- Campers, live-in trailers, tents must obtain a "Pass" from show and be visible. Charges apply.
- Dogs allowed only once signed in at office. Pay the Doggie fee of \$30.00 (% of proceeds go to Animal care groups). Dogs not allowed in the stable or show arena area, vendors or food court. Campsites are allowable. No off leash! \$50.00 fine and removal of competitor from showgrounds w/ no refunds.
- Campgrounds must be free from horses.
- Please lunge in designated areas only.
- Use manure wagons to dispose of stall manure only.
- "A" In- barn wash-racks for boarder residents only. Public rack outside "C" barn. "D" barn and "E" barn.
- Pick-up garbage and place in or next to dumpster.
- Horses may move-in after 1:00 pm the day prior to event. Earlier arrivals must be cleared through Donida Farm.
- No stall construction changes allowed. Any damage to stalls will incur a damage fee.
- No nails in stall. Tack stalls will be charged \$ 20.00 for nails.
- No riding on race-track unless permission is granted from Donida Farm.
- Bagged shavings available at \$10.00 bag. Pre-order on entry or order at show office.

- Donida farm boarders have the right to use the warm-up areas.
