October 15, 2018: Board your overnight flight. Your tour begins the next day.

October 16, 2018: Arrival in Florence, Italy

Welcome to Florence, the "Cradle of the Renaissance. Meet your tour director at the airport for a transfer to the hotel. Then join your Local guide for a walking tour and admire the magnificent DUOMO, with its incredible Renaissance dome designed by Filippo Brunelleschi, Giotto's Bell Tower, the Baptistery's heavy bronze "Gate of Paradise," sculpture-studded SIGNORIA SQUARE, and take pictures of Ponte Vecchio. Enjoy free time for lunch. Check into your hotel. Join your Tour Director later for a welcome dinner at the hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 17, 2018: Florence

Start the day with Mass at the Basilica of Santa Croce. Then follow your local guide and visit the ACADEMY OF FINE ARTS with Michelangelo's celebrated David. Also visit the DANTE HOUSE MUSEUM and enjoy time to explore the SAN LORENZO MARKET. Your afternoon and evening are at leisure. Your Tour Director will have plenty of suggestions on how to make the most of your day in Florence. Tonight drive out to the rolling Chianti Hills and enjoy a traditional Tuscan meal, including coffee and drinks, in a picturesque country setting. This wonderful dinner with regional dishes and wine is prepared using the finest local ingredients - Realize your dreams and live the Tuscan life for an evening! (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 19, 2018: Florence - Assisi

Head south to the hilltop village of Assisi, the home of St Francis and St Clare. Upon arrival join your local guide for a walking tour of Assisi. Visit the BASILICAS OF ST. FRANCIS and ST. CLARE, and see the crucifix that spoke to St. Francis. A short trip by minibus takes you to the CARCERI HERMITAGE, a peaceful oasis in the woods of Mount Subasio where St. Francis came to pray. Finally, visit the MONASTERY OF ST. DAMIAN, a Franciscan shrine built on the spot where St. Francis heard the voice of Christ, and where he wrote the Canticle of the Creatures. The convent founded by St. Clare is still intact, and is where she died in 1253. Enjoy an included lunch and then enjoy the afternoon and evening are at leisure. (Breakfast, Lunch)

October 19, 2018: Assisi - Orvieto

Start the day with mass and a visit to ST. MARY OF THE ANGELS BASILICA, where St. Francis consecrated St. Clare as the "Bride of Christ," and the PORTIUNCULA, where he founded the Franciscan Order of Friars Minor in 1209. Continue to a local Tuscan Vineyard for a TASTING and discover the art of winemaking. Then continue to Orvieto perched high atop a volcanic rock. Hear the history of this fascinating town from your Local Guide during a pleasant walk through the narrow lanes and visit the CATHEDRAL with its San Brizio Chapel. Then a unique visit to the ETRUSCAN UNDERGROUND Labirinto (labyrinth) awaits you. Dinner is included tonight. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 20, 2018: Orvieto - Montecassino - Sorrento

Leave Orvieto and journey south to the charming, bayside resort of Sorrento. Stop in Montecassino for a Mass and visit to the ABBEY OF MONTECASSINO, the first of the Benedictine monasteries founded by St Benedict in 529. Dinner is included tonight. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 21, 2018: Sorrento. Excursion to Amalfi Coast

Enjoy a scenic drive up to the Madonnina, a breathtaking viewpoint over the Amalfi Coast. Free time to visit and shop in the quaint terraced village of Positano, a prosperous port of the former Amalfi Republic. Celebrate Mass at the Byzantine church of Santa Maria Assunta, famous for its majolica tile dome. Return to Sorrento and enjoy the remainder of the afternoon enjoying Sorrento's shops and cheerful cafes. Dinner is included tonight at a local restaurant. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 22, 2018: Sorrento - Pompeii - Rome

Stop for a guided visit of POMPEII, the Roman city both destroyed and preserved by an eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD. This evening, back in the "Eternal City," enjoy dinner at the hotel. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 23, 2018: Rome. Major Basilicas

Today visit ST. PAUL OUTSIDE THE WALLS, one of Rome's four major Papal basilicas, and explore the mysterious ancient CATACOMBS that run under the city. During the persecutions, the catacombs were used as places of refuge for the celebration of the Eucharist. Next, visit ST. JOHN LATERAN BASILICA and the HOLY STAIRS, which were brought from Jerusalem to Rome around 326 AD by St. Helena, mother of Constantine the Great. Officially, pilgrims may only ascend these 28 white marble steps on their knees. Then, visit the hallowed halls of ST. MARY MAJOR BASILICA, another of Rome's four major Papal basilicas. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 24, 2018: Rome. Papal Audience

This morning, attend the PAPAL AUDIENCE (subject to availability) for the chance to see the Pope and receive the Papal Blessing. After free time for lunch at leisure visit ST PETERS SQUARE and BASILICA. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure. Tonight a SEMI-PRIVATE VISIT OF VATICAN MUSEUMS followed by dinner at a local restaurant. (Breakfast, Dinner)

October 25, 2018: Rome. Excursion to Castel Gandolfo

Celebrate early Mass at the Crypt of St Peters. Then join your Tour Director for a drive out of Rome through the Alban Hills to Castel Gandolfo, a small town occupying a height overlooking Lake Albano. It is best known as the summer residence of the Pope. Enjoy an orientation tour of the town and then visit the VATICAN OBSERVATORY and the GARDENS DI VILLA BARBERINI. Continue to the nearby town of Frascati. Frascati is renowned for its white wine and is also an important historical and artistic center. Enjoy an included lunch in a charming atmosphere overlooking Lake Albano before returning back to Rome. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Note - The Gardens di Villa Barberini in Castel Gandolfo can only confirm reservations 60 days prior the operation day. The visit is subject to availability at booking. There is a maximum of 25 passengers per group and the tour duration is 2 hours.

October 26, 2018: Departure from Rome

A group transfer is provided to the Rome airport for your flight home today. (Breakfast)
