CONFESSIONS

Heidelberg Catechism

Q 90. What is the coming to life of the new nature?

A. It is a heartfelt joy in God through Christ, and a love and delight to live according to the will of God in all good works.

Q 91. But what are good works?

A. Only those which are done out of true faith, in accordance with the law of God, and to His glory, and not those based on our own opinion or on precepts of men.

Reflection Questions (Applying the Gospel to Our Lives):

1. If Jesus had NOT risen from the dead, would there be any difference in how you lived your life than how you are living now?
2. Why did the women and the apostles find it hard to believe in the resurrection? How does this argue for the resurrection? What helps us believe?
3. Are you still trying to earn God's favor? How does this go against how Jesus 'must' be crucified? Are you living a victorious life? How does this go with how Jesus 'must' rise on the third day?
4. How does the resurrection of Jesus Christ make a difference in your day-to-day life? How is your fellowship with our living Lord?
