Reflection Questions (Applying the Gospel to Our Lives):

1. Unity among God's people is a chief concern throughout the Bible. Have you seen disunity destroy a church? Share. How do you find yourself responding to moments of disunity in the church (e.g. "Not my business," cynical-judgmental, stirring the pot more, leaving, etc.)? And more personally, how do you respond to friction and tension with others?
2. Unity in the church is fostered by the humility of its members. According to Paul, humility is expressed by "counting others more significant than yourselves" and "looking after the interests of others." What do you think biblical humility looks like in action? In what ways do you struggle with humility?
3. Paul motivates us to humility by thinking deeply about Jesus and the gospel. In contrast, how does the unbelieving world motivate people to humility? What is it about the gospel (esp. vv. 5-8) that reaches our hearts and transforms us into humble people?
