CONFESSIONS

Heidelberg Catechism

Q 80. What difference is there between the Lord's supper and the papal mass?

A. The Lord's supper testifies to us, first, that we have complete forgiveness of all our sins through the one sacrifice of Jesus Christ, which He Himself accomplished on the cross once for all; and, second, that through the Holy Spirit we are grafted into Christ, who with His true body is now in heaven at the right hand of the Father, and this is where he wants to be worshiped. But the mass teaches, first, that the living and the dead do not have forgiveness of sins through the suffering of Christ unless he is still offered for them daily by the priests; and, second, that Christ is bodily present in the form of bread and wine, and there is to be worshiped. Therefore, the mass is basically nothing but a denial of the one sacrifice and suffering of Jesus Christ, and an accursed idolatry.

When we are gripped by the beauty of God's justice and mercy in Christ, then we will delight in serving others for justice and mercy!

3. Where do you see mercy in chapter 20? What is wrong with being judgmental of others for not serving?
4. How does God show himself to be just and merciful at the same time in Jesus Christ?
5. End by praying for the needy in the City of San Diego.
