CONFESSIONS

Q 97. May we then not make any image at all?

A. God cannot and may not be visibly portrayed in any way. Creatures may be portrayed, but God forbids us to make or have any images of them in order to worship them or to serve God through them.

Q 98. But may images not be tolerated in the churches as “books for the laity”?

A. No, for we should not be wiser than God. He wants His people to be taught not by means of dumb images but by the living preaching of His Word.

Reflection Questions (Applying the Gospel to Our Lives):

1. Do you have a tendency toward pointing out or thinking about others’ sins, but not your own? Why do you think you do this?
2. Why did signs and wonders accompany prophetic gifts like tongues? Should we all expect to prophesy?
3. When was the last time you shared the gospel with someone and what did you share?
4. Have you ever been cut to the heart by the conviction of your sin? Why is it important that we continue to repent of our sins?
5. Pray together asking for the Spirit to help each person at Hope to be a better gospel witness.
