### \*MAKE IT HOLIDAY

To make your everyday makeup a little more holiday, try adding something a little glossy on top of your regular blush; this will help make your cheeks pop without having to add a lot more color. If you want to be bold, go with red lips. There are so many shades of red, everyone can find the right color. Nothing says holiday like red lips!

### \*ALL THAT GLITTERS

My big rule for glitter: Only accent one feature at a time. Glitter can add excitement to any look, but putting too much on your face can look clownish. Splashing a little glitter on the eyelids to bring a pop of color to your look is my favorite way to wear it. Another fun and easy way to add "sparkle" to your look is to use spray glitter on your hair. The key to success when using glitter: A little bit goes a long way, and it's easier to add more glitter than it is to take it away!

### \*SO MANY PARTIES

The best way to not repeat your makeup look during the holiday season is by making lipcolor changes. Lipcolor is something both women and men love, so people will notice. If you know you have four holiday parties, run out and find four fun lipcolors that work for you. You'll definitely be noticed and look different in all the fabulous selfies... I mean you do need to document the color changes, right?

### \*AFTER HOURS

My favorite way to change your makeup look to go from the office to a holiday party is with powder, blush, mascara and eyeliner. These four items are powerful tools when transitioning your look. Powder will matte the skin and make you look refreshed. Blush will add extra color and glow to your cheeks and, in a pinch, you can add some to your eyelids for a pop of color. Eyeliner will enhance your day look into an evening look; use it to create a smoky feel simply by smudging. Mascara adds drama to the lashes.

### \*DANCE THE NIGHT AWAY

If your holiday parties involve a lot of dancing, wearing smudge-proof products will help with any slipping makeup. There are also some great setting sprays on the market that artists use to set the whole look; these are available to the general public and work great. Powder is your best friend for the skin.
