Dear Parishioner,

We're excited to let you know that we are proceeding with a Capital Campaign for St. Boniface. The Vestry made this decision following many discussions and the results of a survey in which 87% of respondents indicated that they are in favor of a capital campaign.

The theme for our campaign is **Reduce, Renew, Reignite**. We've selected this theme because it represents our goals for this campaign:

Reduce our mortgage debt.

Renew our church building through projects that will make our structure more energy efficient and help preserve our church for future generations.

Reignite our passion to fulfill our mission and spread the gospel.

Our goal for the campaign is \$180,000. Pledges can be paid over a two-year period.

In feedback provided in the survey, the following were identified as the top initiatives to be addressed.

- Reducing the mortgage
- Replacing windows and doors in the administration wing and old nave. Estimated cost \$44,000.
- Renovating the old nave to better support year round use as a fellowship hall through improved insulation, installation of drywall, new furnace and ductwork. Estimated cost \$44,000.
- Adding an air conditioning/heat pump to the Cleaver Room to improve the comfort for meetings. Estimated cost \$5,500.

Parishioners will be able to designate the portion of their gift to apply to debt reduction and the portion to apply to facilities improvements. The Vestry has stated that a project will not begin until the funds for that project have been received.

That covers the **Reduce** and **Renew** elements of our campaign. **Reignite** is what we believe will be an outcome of a successful campaign – an energizing of our commitment to acting as God's hands in this world. Throughout and after this campaign we seek to engage with one another, supporting each other in our efforts and encouraging each other to give from the heart. The following people have taken on leadership roles in this campaign:

We are excited to be undertaking this capital campaign. Excited because we believe in the effort, believe that we can be successful and look forward to the positive outcomes when we come together as one congregation to Reduce, Renew and Reignite.
