Suggested Packing List

- **In-Camp clothes:** Enough for seven days. Steer clear of clothing that others could find offensive or inappropriate. Remember: it can get cooler in the evenings, so we suggest bringing a few warmer clothes and a lightweight jacket.
- **Work:** Sneakers or work boots. Open-toed or open- heeled shoes are not allowed on worksites. Long pants. Shirts with sleeves. Be sure there are no rips or holes in the clothing in areas which others may find offensive.
- **In-camp shoes:** You must wear shoes at all times, even in camp. Open-toed shoes are allowed at all camp locations.

Toiletries

- **Towels:** For bathing, swimming, and sitting on the ground outside.
- **Bedding:** Sheets and blanket for a single bed, or a sleeping bag. Don't forget a pillow!
- **Hammer:** Bring your own hammer, preferably a 16 oz. claw hammer.
- **Safety goggles:** Bring your own pair of safety goggles (ordinary sunglasses or prescription glasses don't count).
- **Work gloves:** Bring your own pair of work gloves, preferably tough and durable.

Recommended

- Flashlight
- Bathing suit: No bikinis, thongs, Speedos, or other revealing bathing

suits allowed! Bathing suits must be one-piece or tankini-style. At most camps, swimming may be permitted during evening hours, but only when a lifeguard is present. If anyone in your group is a certified lifeguard and would volunteer as a lifeguard during certain times, please have them bring their current certification with them.

- Sunscreen
- Sandals for the shower
- Insect repellent
- Some extra spending money: The staff will have snacks, drinks, and CCC merchandise for sale at reasonable prices.
- Copy of Insurance card
- Guitar or other instruments you might play
- Lawn Chair: Great for free-time and outdoor activities.
- Ear Plugs: If you're sensitive to people snoring.
- Any special costumes or skit props: Friday night campfire will give you a chance to perform.
- Devotional materials or music
- Stationary: If you want to write folks back home, our staff will be glad to take your letters and postcards to the post office for you. Feel free to have folks write you; there will be mail call each evening
