General Qualifications Required

1. Love God
 - Volunteers be of good character and of the Christian faith
 - Attend worship services regularly at Clemmons UMC
 - Commit to growing in your faith through study, prayer, service, and worship.
2. Love Students
 - Attend weekly ONE meeting, if possible.
 - Small group leaders: create & oversee one social event a month for your respective group. Call/write students who have not attended church the past few weeks.
 - Sunday School teachers: create (with Clark's help) and implement weekly Sunday morning curriculum.
 - All volunteers: attend special trips/retreats/events as needed or if possible.
 - Commit to pray for our students.
3. Love Yourself
 - Take time out for yourself and/or family to grow closer to Christ, even if you have to say "no" to a student ministry event.
 - Live a life of godly character and Christian principle as an example for students to follow.
 - Commit to attend volunteer training events as they are offered.

Time Commitment

- Adult volunteers serving in the capacity of Sunday School teachers agree to serve for a minimum of one school year.
- Adult volunteers serving as small group leaders agree to serve for the longevity of the student's eventual high school tenure.
- Sunday School teachers: 2-3 hours a week (at Sunday School, at ONE, preparing lessons, contacting absent students).
- Small group leaders: 2-3 hours a week (at small group, at ONE, holding small group events, contacting absent students).
