

INTRODUCTION

Magical processes involve *intention* and *attention*. We start with intention, whether conscious or unconscious. Then, we focus our attention through thoughts, spells, or ritual practices.

Unconscious intentions are ones set by our subconscious self or higher self, aspects of ourselves that may not be prevalent in our minds. Conscious intentions are the ones we say aloud or think, like, "I'd like to start a new career" or "I want to fall in love." These are the kinds we make during rituals or spells.

After we set an intention, we focus our spiritual power and direct it toward the fulfillment of that intention. Symbols and magical tools can help with this because they give our minds a focal point and bring us into our bodies. When we bring our awareness into our bodies, we ground our spiritual energy and support the realization of our desires.

Symbols work with the unconscious aspects of ourselves. They have layers of meaning. When we use magical symbols like herbs, botanicals, or fragrances, we involve ourselves in performance to the divine sources of magic. We honor all of the elements of the earth, too, trusting them to carry our intentions through the earth, air, fire, and water. We sync up with the waves of the cosmos by aligning our intentions with astrological elements, planets, and signs.

This book of correspondences is a resource to help you plan rituals, spells, and even day-to-day activities.

ADJECTIVE


- Having or apparently having supernatural powers. 'A magic wand'

These lines paraphrase those written by Hermes Trismegistus in the *Emerald Tablet* help explain the law of correspondences. The microcosm is as the macrocosm. Everything on earth – down to the smallest molecules – has astrological correspondence. When you learn to work with the symbols, plants, and minerals associated with each planet or sign, you become more magical in your everyday life.

When I was starting to work with magic in my late teens, I was often confused about which crystals to have on my altar or what incense to burn at each full moon. This is the book I *wish* I had then!

Ways to create sacred space:

- Surround yourself with light.
- Intention is everything.
- Create an altar with crystals, candles, herbs, flowers, and other sacred objects.
- Work with crystals that support the intentions you have in mind.
- Light candles and work with different herbs, making tinctures and teas.
- Infuse everything with magic.

Incenses for clearing space:

- Lavender
- Rosemary
- Cedar
- Frankincense
- Pine resin
- Sage (sourced ethically, without cultural appropriation)

Ritualize It! prepare yourself for big magic!

When you prepare a ritual or spell, it's best to work with the astrological energies that best support the kind of intentions you have in mind. Incorporate the herbs, fragrances, botanicals, crystals, and symbols associated with the planets you want to invoke.

You can plan day to day activities through correspondences as well. For example, if you want to socialize, choose Friday, Venus day. Declutter on Saturday, Saturn's day. Send your emails out on Wednesday, Mercury's day. Different planetary days highlight the activities connected to those planets.


Invoke a Planet

MEDITATION

Center your awareness on your crown chakra (right above the crown of your head), and say the name of the planet you'd like to invoke three times. Welcome in that energy. Allow it to flow from your head throughout your body. Feel it moving through the base of your body and connect to the earth. Ground that energy.

Wear a stone representing that planet for seven days, and set a timer to stop in the middle of the day to do a short meditation on that planet.

Drink teas or wear fragrances associated with that planet. You can mix herb or oil blends together as well.



WORKING WITH MAGIC

Magic is spiritual energy, a resource of power. When we focus it in specific ways during rituals or when we're making magical items, we embody magic and work with it in our lives.

The rituals we do bridge the gap between the physical and nonphysical -- the realm of the spiritual. The items we make (like talismans, amulets, or candles) hold a concentration of sacred energy that encapsulates our intentions.

Working with astrological magic helps us sync up with the waves of the cosmos and maximize the energy available to support our magical practices. Astrology and magic have always gone hand in hand. Here are some ways to use magical astrology.



WAYS TO WORK WITH MAGIC

- **Divination** Seeking guidance from divination tools, like tarot cards, automatic writing, tea leaves, astrology, and more.
- **Healing** Sending magical energy into the places of the mind, body, or spirit that most need healing.
- Spells Working with specific intentions in spells.
- Tinctures or oils Making blends of oils, herbs, and essences with magical properties.
- Amulets These are items you make or find and charge with the function of protecting you.
- **Making Candle Magic** Etch a magical symbol into a candle or draw it on the side of the candle. Burn the candle to fuel your intention.
- Community Rituals We can gather in groups for a shared intention.
- Bath Salts You can make bath salts with herbs, crystals, and other essences.
- **Potpurri with Magical Herbs** Fill your home with the fragrance of magic. Boil magical herbs in a pot to release the intentions in the air.
- **Miscellaneous** Anything in your life can be magical! Bring spiritual presence to your dinner preparations, nighttime bath, tucking your kids into bed, or any other daily ritual.

WORKING WITH MAGIC

Once you open yourself to magic, you can see it working in your everyday life. You begin to feel more connected to all of life: to nature, people, possibilities, and yourself.


MAGICAL ASTROLOGY

Align your intention with the planet or sign you most wish to invoke. Incorporate herbs, colors, fragrances, crystals, and foods ruled by the planet or sign that best fits your intention. Add them to your altar space, make teas with the herbs, or place essential oils on your pulse points.

It's helpful to time your rituals and spiritual practices with the planetary days of the week.

Each day encapsulates the spirit of a different planet:

Sunday - Sun Monday - Moon Tuesday - Mars Wednesday - Mercury Thursday - Jupiter Friday - Venus Saturday - Saturn



Plan activities that coincide with the planetary days. For example, Venus is the planet of beauty and style. You could plan your trip to the salon on Friday. Mercury is the planet of communication; email your proposals and important correspondences out on Wednesday to align with Mercury.

MAGICAL ASTROLOGY (CONTINUED)

You can also work with planetary hours. Every day has 24 hours, and those hours each have a corresponding planetary ruler. We start with the sunrise as the beginning of the first planetary hour. From sunrise to sunset, that's considered daytime. You divide the times into equal planetary hours. So, they might not be exactly 60 minutes. Then, you start over at sunset with the night hours.*
