



Mission in the Economy (MitE) is seeking to appoint a Lead Chaplain to manage and develop chaplaincy and community activities at Liverpool John Lennon Airport, as well as chaplaincy provision in Liverpool City Centre. The ideal person will have excellent organizational skills, be passionate about enabling people to be the best that they can be and have a desire to make a difference to the people that they are working with.

MitE is an ecumenical Christian provider of workplace chaplaincy across the Merseyside region. The chaplains come alongside people, providing a friendly listening ear to people of all faiths and none. As an independent presence in the workplace, MitE's chaplains are ideally placed to provide a confidential and safe space to enable those they meet to flourish in their work life, wellbeing and spirituality.

The role is clearly defined between the Airport and the City Centre, with 16 hours/week allocated to developing the chaplaincy team to LJLA. There is the possibility of these hours increasing in the future. The Lead Chaplain would work to recruit, develop and strengthen the availability and reputation of a chaplaincy team. The Lead Chaplain will also work closely with the Community Liaison team to coordinate and deliver community projects.

The remaining 4 hours/week are allocated to a role with MitE to coordinate the chaplaincy team in Liverpool City Centre. The Lead Chaplain would be expected to manage and develop the current volunteer chaplains whilst recruiting and training new volunteers to the team.

This post is open to both lay and ordained people.

The Lead Chaplain will usually be located at Liverpool John Lennon Airport, Speke, Liverpool and Liverpool City Centre but may be required to attend elsewhere within the region.
