TRANSITIONAL MINISTRY

January to July 1st were full months for the Leadership Team, and for you the community. We worked through some very significant portions of the transitional process: who we were, who we are now and who we want to be. *Part* of this was aligning on what our understanding of key concepts like priesthood of all believers, and the role of the pastor as it relates to the leadership structure at ECC is. This phase of the transitional process we're on culminated in publishing the [Pastoral Job Profile for ECC](#) and commissioning the Search Team. The Elders and others involved are super grateful for the amount of prayer, feedback and support extended to us by you all during what we would consider to be a critical time in our Church's story.

As it relates to the transitional period that we are in, the immediate next steps for us as a whole community are:

2. Continue to pray for the missional posture of ECC. Essentially, how we view the community / family dynamic, which is such a wonderful strength for our church, and how the Lord would have us use it for his Kingdom.
3. Elder / Congregation relationship and exploring the idea of membership
