## Champagne

### Fernand Lemaire Premier Cru Brut, Hautvillers • 64

Fernand Lemaire owns just 7 ha of vines. A 50/50 Chardonnay Pinot Noir blend of Premier Cru grapes produce this wonderfully balanced wine with refreshing acidity, toasty brioche notes and bright citrus fruit.

### Fernand Lemaire Millesime 2010, Hautvillers • 92

A wonderful vintage Premier Cru Champagne from a small family house in Hautvillers, the birthplace of Champagne. Honeysuckle and citrus aromas are followed by a wonderful persistent crystalline freshness.

### Louis Roederer Brut Nature 2006, Montagne de Reims • 158

Designed in collaboration with French designer Philippe Starck this is excellent dry Champagne. Elegant and creamy with notes of sun-drenched fruit and toasted hazlenuts.

## Sparkling

### Bocchoris Brut Cava, Penedes • 34

Produced from a vineyard of only 13 hectares, dry but smooth, this Brut-quality Cava is well balanced and very refreshing.

### Cesarini Sforza Tridentum 2011, Trento • 48

Pinot Nero based from the far north of Italy, a very dry lively wine with citrus and green apple aromas and softer nutty and brioche notes on the palate. 36 months of lees aging gives this great depth and persistence.

### Gramona Imperial Gran Reserva Brut 2011, Penedes • 68

Extended lees ageing and over 48 months of bottle maturation has produced this full-bodied and creamy wine with notes of white flowers, freshly baked bread and citrus.

## White

### Pirineos 3404 2016, Somontano • 23

Hailing from Somontano, one of Spain's coolest wine regions right up towards the Pyrenees north east of Rioja, this wine has a beautiful freshness with tropical fruit notes and balanced acidity.

### Agerre Txakoli 2017, Getaria • 26

A Basque classic- sea breeze, lemon peel, crunchy pear, crisp acidity and the perfect gentle spritz.

### Pionero Maccerato Albariño 2016, Rias Baixas • 33

Made with grapes from top vineyard sites in Albariño's spiritual home Rias Baixas, this wine shows excellent typicity. The nose, a complex combination of grapefruit, herbs, citrus and green fruits, the palate a balance of honeysuckle richness with refreshing acidity and a stony finish.

### Arndorfer Strassertal 2016, Kamptal • 34

Clean and elegant with classic Gruner Veltliner citrus notes and refreshing acidity, this organic unfiltered wine also displays a more complex and powerful quality.

### Joaquin Rebolledo Godello 2015, Valdeorras • 35

From the granite and slate soils that border the river Sil in Galicia, this is wonderfully aromatic with peach, anise and ripe apple. Full and textured on the palate and a firm mineral finish.

### Picarana 2016, Vinos de Madrid • 41

Created from the indigenous Spanish grape Albillo and fermented in barrel, jasmine and tropical fruit flavours are evident with a weight and richness bound together with refreshing minerality.

### Petroni Sauvignon Blanc 2010, Sonoma Valley • 42

The combination of ripe acidity and time spent in French oak has meant this wine is still drinking well seven years after harvest. Exotic and floral notes abound followed by bruised white peach and a creamy finish.

### Trenzado 2015, Tenerife • 45

A field blend of local varieties from the talented winemaking team at Suertes del Marques. Dry, lightly nutty, slightly oaky and with lots of tang.

### Extramundi 2016, Ribeiro • 48

An Atlantic influenced blend of Albariño and Treixadura by highly regarded winemaker Oscar Aragón. There's a saline mouthfeel with lots of apricot and peach fruit, and a long refreshing finish.

### Oremus Mandolas 2015/16, Tokaji • 52

A dry version of Hungary's normally sweet Furmint produced by Vega Sicilia. The nose of stewed pears and baked apples is misleading as the palate is soft and dry with a definitive richness and full mouthfeel.

### Viña Gravonia Blanco Crianza 2007/08, Rioja • 54

An excellent example of a traditional mature white Rioja. Aged for four years in large 500-litre old oak barrels this is rich, oaky and brimming with fruit and zesty grapefruit acidity.

### La Mar Terras Gauda 2015, Rias Baixas • 59

With 85% Caino Blanco this wine has intense aromas of sweet hay and ripe tropical fruit. Textured on the palate with crunchy nectarine marked with ginger and balanced with a fresh acidity.

### Domaine du Monteillet 2016, St Joseph • 66

Skillfully crafted old vine Marsanne and Roussanne by a rising star in the Northern Rhone, this wine hints of lemon, apricot, peach and marzipan with a textured and generous palate, firm minerality and slight spiciness.

### Terra de Cuques 2015, Priorat • 72

Produced by the highly-regarded Dominik Huber at Terroir Al Limit who farms biodynamically, hand harvests the grapes and relies on natural yeasts. This blend of Pedro Ximénez and Muscat d'Alexandria is wonderfully deep and vibrant with citrus peel and a flinty minerality.

### Quinta da Pellada Primus 2014, Dao • 83

Produced by the Dao's genius winemaker Alvaro Castro, this field blend is reckoned to incorporate 39 varieties, including Encruzado, Cerceal, Bical, Verdelho and Terrantez. They are blended harmoniously to create an initially subtle wine which builds and unleashes a wave of mineral, candied pear and balanced nut flavours.

### Tondonia Blanco Reserva 2004, Rioja • 84

Only released last year after spending six years in barrel and the rest in bottle in the wineries ancient cellars. This is powerful and complex with spice, vanilla and piercing lemon and apple fruit.

### Belondrade y Lurton 2015, Rueda • 85

Fully organic and created in the Burgundian style this 100% barrel fermented Verdejo has excellent weight, texture and a beautifully long finish.

### As Sortes 2015, Valdeorras • 85

Using organic and biodynamic methods Rafael Palacios has crafted a wine of complexity and elegance, power and minerality. Pear, nectarine and floral notes abound.

## Rosé

### Cillar de Silos 2016, Ribera del Duero • 33

Made in the Provencal style by the esteemed Ribera estate Cillar de Silos, this old vine Tempranillo has intense aromas of wild strawberries, gooseberries and fennel and a long mineral finish.

## Red

### Montnegre 2015, Mallorca • 24

Tiny production field blend of Mantonegro, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon from a boutique family estate, this island wine is packed with ripe red fruit, herbs and a delicious freshness

### Casa Castillo 2015, Jumilla • 29

Organically grown Monastrell is used by this small family run bodega to produce a full bodied balanced wine with intense cherry and ripe plums and hints of spice and balsamic.

### La Fanfarria 2016, Asturias • 31

A biodynamic offering from Dominio del Urogallo composed of old vine Albarin Tinto and Mencia grown on the extremely high slopes in the Cangas region of Asturias. Soft red and black fruit are complimented by the lively acidity and mineral finish.

### Eridano Crianza 2014, Rioja • 33

Located in La Rioja the small family run bodegas that produces this Crianza grows their Tempranillo in their own vineyards which lie 500m above sea level. This imparts a lovely freshness in the wine which proves the perfect foil for the abundant dark fruit and evident smoky oak

### Treintamil Maravedies 2015, Vinos de Madrid • 38

In the midst of the Gredos mountains, Grenache grapes are grown organically and after vinification aged for 8 months in French oak, all producing a wine full of wild berries and herbs, smooth and full.

### La Solona 2014, Tenerife • 43

Listan Negro is supposedly a neutral grape, but not here! This wine is very aromatic and perfumed with a fruity and feminine palate showing very fine minerality, medium body and a great length.

### Miros de Ribera Reserva 2012, Ribera del Duero • 45

A wonderful example of what Ribera del Duero has to offer - black cherry with silky fine tannins, leaving rich smoke and black pepper flavours on the palate. Big aromatic bouquet and a hint of toasted wood.

### Princep del Priorat 2014, Priorat • 47

A blend of hand-harvested Garnacha, Cariñena, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Syrah aged for 8 months in French oak. Deep and brooding with ripe red fruit, sweet spice and a touch of cinnamon.

### Finca l'Argatà 2014, Montsant • 48

24 hectares are worked bio-dynamically by the seventh generation of the same family using wild yeasts and whole-bunch fermentation. This Garnacha-Syrah blend shows ripe black fruits, spices and smooth fresh tannins.

### Hens & Seals 2014, Mallorca • 57

A Manto Negra/Syrah blend this wine is made by the talented group at the 4 Kilos winery. Deep dark fruit flavours with spice, earth and a lovely electric minerality.

### Remelluri Reserva 2010, Rioja • 59

Made from grapes grown exclusively on the Remelluri Estate, this wine has savoury spicy notes with bright cherry, dark chocolate and leather on the palate. A remarkable wine from a legendary vineyard.

### Laurel 2015, Priorat • 77

This is second wine to the much-heralded Clos Erasmus, coming from the younger vines in the small biodynamic vineyards. Complex herbs, oaky spice and chocolate richness dominate the palate alongside charming, opulent fruit.

### 4 Kilos 2015, Mallorca • 78

A blend of Callet, Fogoneu, Syrah and Cabernet Sauvignon this modern-day classic has a rich succulent texture and mineral edge with lashings of ripe cherries and blackberries and well-integrated oak.

### A Torna Dos Pasas Escolma 2011, Ribeiro • 81

Luis Rodriguez's top cuvee produced from a field blend of old, low yielding Caiño, Brancellao and Ferrol vines. Complex and medium bodied with an abundance of wild red fruit, leather and spices.

### Viña Tondonia Reserva 2005, Rioja • 83

Wonderful, traditional, elegant Rioja, a result of Tondonia's extending ageing process (bottled after six years in oak barrels). Aromas of spice, leather, cherries and cigar box precede the round and crisp palate with a luxurious mouth feel and intense core of flavour.

### La Dama 2013, Navarra • 84

Garnacha grapes are hand-picked from vines with an average age of 75 years (some even reaching 113!) and then aged in French oak for 14 months. This wine is very rich, medium-bodied but with a lovely freshness and a long finish of black cherry, wild red berries and a hint of spice.

### Dominio de Pingus 'Psi' 2015, Ribera del Duero • 89

A project by Pingus founder Peter Sisseck following organic and biodynamic farming. Generous black fruit aromas are nicely tempered with a light touch of oak. An excellent balance between the tannin, depth and length.

### Retortoiro 2013, Asturias • 93

Made predominately with bio-dynamically cultivated Verdejo Tinto grapes and aged for 15 months in small French oak barrels, this small batch wine shows spicy mineral notes and a body radiating balance and finesse.

### Quinta de Pellada 2003, Dao • 95

Produced by the enigmatic Alvaro Castro from Touriga Nacional this has a wonderfully perfumed, open nose which is beautifully forward and elegant with some spicy, meaty notes. The palate is balanced, showing a spicy, earthy tannic structure from the age.

### Macán 2013, Rioja Alta • 138

A joint venture by Rothschild and Vega Sicilia, the 2013 is considered the best yet. Notes of fine leather and dark fruits and a palate vividly fresh, with black cherries and balsamic flavours.

### Alion 2013, Ribera del Duero • 144

Pure Tempranillo from over 30-year-old vines in different villages is fermented in oak vats then aged for 14 months in new French barriques. The 2013 is a slightly lighter vintage, an elegant Alion. Medium-bodied with a concentrated core of dark fruits and lifted acidity.

## Magnums

### Champagne

Fernand Lemaire Premier Cru Brut, Hautvillers • 134

Fernand Lemaire owns just 7ha of vines. This 50/50 Chardonnay Pinot Noir blend from Premier Cru vineyards is wonderfully balanced with refreshing acidity, toasty brioche notes and bright citrus fruit.

### White

Zárate Balado 2016, Rias Baixas • 145

A beautiful single-vineyard albariño from one of the leading producers in the region. Very lively with great acidity and concentration, both powerful and fresh.

### Red

Laurel 2015, Priorat • 158

This is second wine to the much-heralded Clos Erasmus, coming from the younger vines in the small biodynamic vineyards. Complex herbs, oaky spice and chocolate richness dominate the palate alongside charming, opulent fruit.

Cantos del Diablo 2013, Méntrida • 188

Made by the acclaimed young winemaker Daniel Landi this is a rich, ripe approach to Garnacha. A fine, perfumed nose is followed by pure red berry fruit expression and a long, velvety finish.

## Sweet

Coteaux du Layon Domaine Vincent Ogereau 2015, Anjou • 7.5/60 (75ml/75cl)

Made from 40 year old Chenin Blanc vines this is extremely elegant and complex with dried fruit, ginger and confit characters.

Txomin Extaniz 'Uydi' Late Harvest Txakoli • 9.2/48 (75ml/50cl)

Beautifully balanced acidity and sweetness characterise this late harvest Txakoli, 12 months of barrel ageing adds to the complexity.

Château Filhot 2009, Sauternes • 13/56 (75ml/33cl)

A Semillon and Sauvignon Blanc blend from a vineyard which originally dates back to the seventeenth century. Notes of quince, honey and bitter orange. Full bodied and rich but wonderfully balanced with refreshing acidity.

Runchet Moscato d'Asti 2015, Piedmont • 36 (75cl)

Organically grown Moscato Bianco grapes are used to create this gently sparkling wine packed with nectarine and blossom notes with a light and refreshing finish.

## Fortified

Maestro Sierra Fino, Jerez (75ml) • 5.8

Aged for 6 years in solera this wine shows yeasty and doughy notes with a dense palate of with bright fruit.

Gabriela Manzanilla, Sanlucar de Barrameda (75ml) • 6.4

A classic Manzanilla, bone dry with plenty of nutty notes and a crisp saline finish.

Maestro Sierra Amontillado, Jerez (75ml) • 8.5

Very dry and bursting with notes of nuts and vanilla and hints of smoke.

Gobernador Oloroso, Jerez (75ml) • 6.7

This is an aromatic, full-bodied oloroso which although dry on the finish has sweet flavours of milk chocolate and hazelnuts.

Hidalgo Pedro Ximenez, Jerez (50ml) • 6

Drying the Pedro Ximenez grapes on straw mats helps to create a wine of unsurpassed sweetness. Incredibly thick and dense with notes of raisins, figs, caramel, nuts and toffee.

Smith Woodhouse 10 year Tawny Port, Douro (50ml) • 6.5

Full of plum and raisin aromas with a long deep finish, slightly less sweet than the norm.

Warre's Quinta de Cavadinha 2004, Douro (50ml) • 9

Seductive flavours of black plums and cherries, with an elegant long and complex finish.
