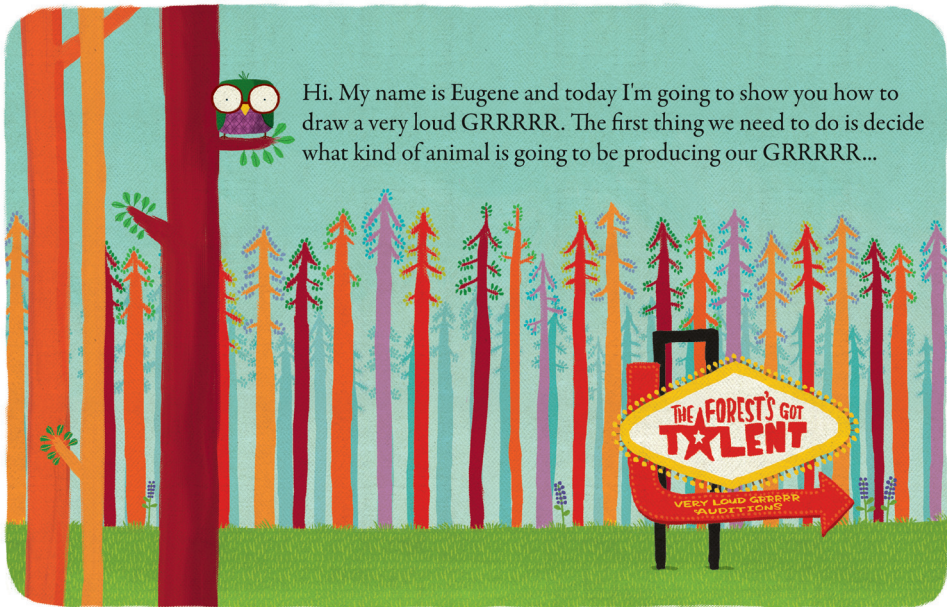


How to draw a very loud

Hi. My name is Eugene and today I'm going to show you how to draw a very loud GRRRRR. The first thing we need to do is decide what kind of animal is going to be producing our GRRRRR...

CONTESTANT NUMBER ONE: Amanda from Leighton Buzzard

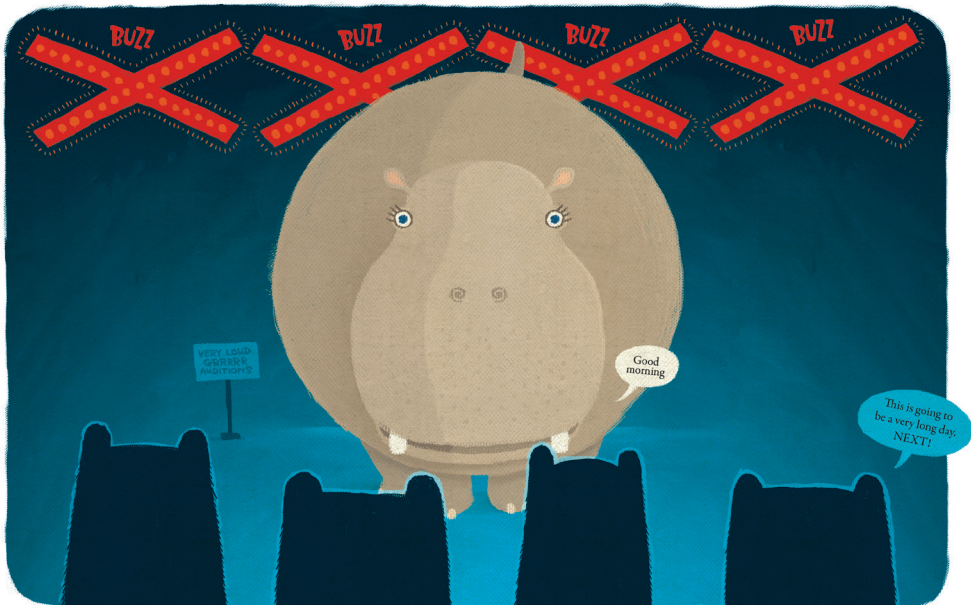

We have a winner!

So we've decided that it's going to be a bear doing our very loud GRRRRRR. Here's how to draw him...



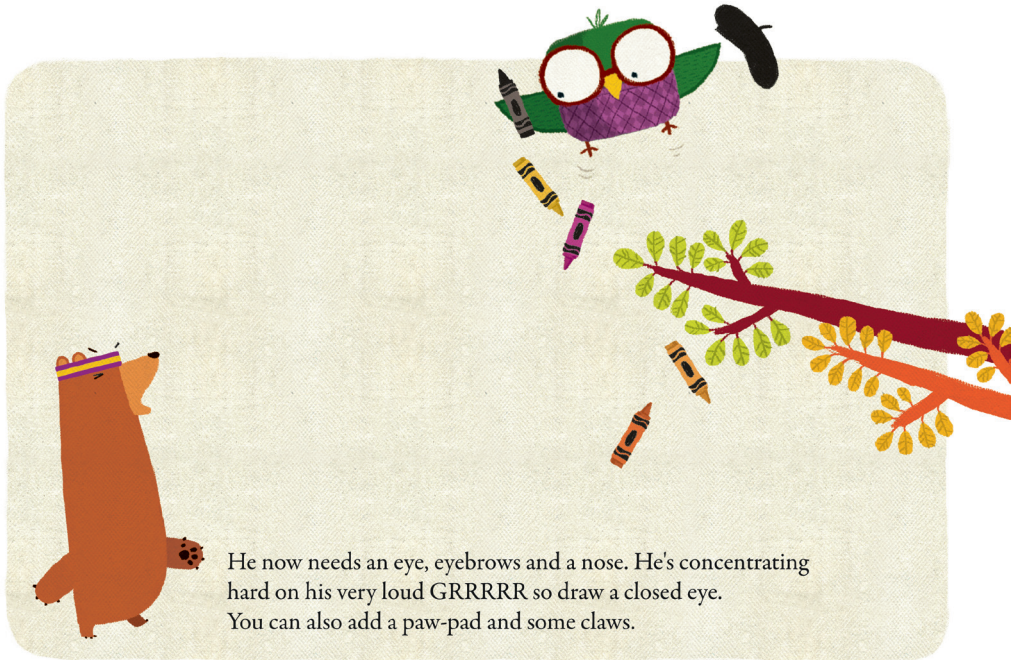
First, we need a shape like this. Draw it on the left hand side of your piece of paper. We need to leave plenty of room on the right for later on.



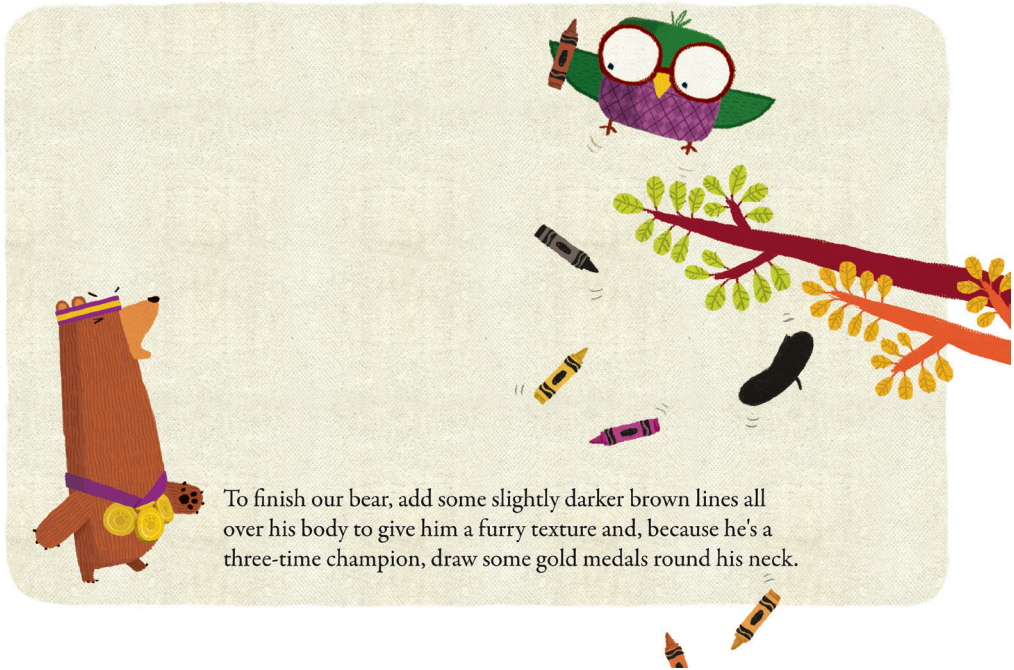
Now let's add some legs and an open-mouthed snout. His left leg should be a slightly darker brown than his right leg.



Next, draw two arms, a nice headband and a pair of ears. Remember, his left arm should be a bit darker than his right.



He now needs an eye, eyebrows and a nose. He's concentrating hard on his very loud GRRRRR so draw a closed eye. You can also add a paw-pad and some claws.



To finish our bear, add some slightly darker brown lines all over his body to give him a furry texture and, because he's a three-time champion, draw some gold medals round his neck.



Now draw in the background leaving a lovely white voice bubble for his GRRRRR.

Now we need to choose a style of font for our GRRRRR.
