You can get involved in a project taking place in your local area.

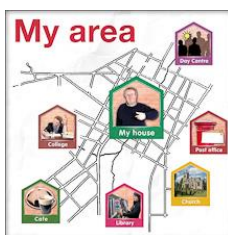
Community projects could be things like getting involved in Learning Disability Week and planning something for that week.
