1 CHOOSE YOUR GIN

Beefeater London Dry 40% 8

Distilled to James Burrough’s original 1860s recipe. Nine botanicals are steeped for 24 hours before distillation to produce a fresh, clean and crisp gin with a subtle citrus and fruit edge.

Bombay Sapphire 40% 8

Vapour infusion of Tuscan juniper and nine precious botanicals releases the distinctive aromas and deliver a fragrant herbal complexity with a broad, balanced flavour.

Brockmans 40% 9

The distinctive gin notes and aroma of coriander married with refreshing influence of citrus and the softer notes of blueberry and blackberry help deliver an exquisite taste experience and an intensely smooth gin.

Copper House Dry 40% 9

Made with six carefully chosen botanicals, Adnams Copper House Dry Gin is elegant and approachable, classically charged with juniper, rich with floral and citrus notes.

Death’s Door 47% 9

An American gin with full London Dry flavour and complexity belying surprisingly simple botanicals. Loaded wild juniper berry flavours up front with spicy, citrusy notes from coriander in the mid-palate, and a soft, cooling finish provided by the fennel infusion.

Four Pillars Rare Dry 41.8% 10

A rare dry gin made in a small distillery in Yarra Valley, Australia. Cinnamon and star anise add rich fruit-cake tones, the Tasmanian pepperberry leaf provides warmth rather than heat, and lemon myrtle is a beautiful alternative to lemon peel. A must for gin-lovers.

Gin Mare 42.7% 10

Distilled by two brothers in a small fishing village near Barcelona, Gin Mare smells and tastes like the essence of the Mediterranean. Smooth, unique and memorable with primary botanicals of Arbequina olives, thyme, basil and rosemary, this deliciously groundbreaking spirit pushes the traditional boundaries of gin flavours.

Hendricks 41.4% 9

Infusions of cucumber and Bulgarian Rosa Damascena petals create a refreshing gin with a delicate, floral aroma. Distilled in tiny batches of 500 litres in rare and unusual stills, this truly is ‘a gin made oddly’.

All gins are served in 50ml measures.

A gin for every taste

Martin Miller's 40% 9

A double distilled premium gin made from nine classic botanicals blended with the purest Icelandic water. Soft on the palate with a gentle delivery of juniper notes.

Monkey 47 47% 10

Predictably complex, this is a robust and powerful gin with plenty of spice, fruit and herb flavours. It is well structured and difficult to unpick but a fresh citrus start surges into pine and wood notes for a drying finish.

Plymouth 41.2% 8

Distilled from a blend of seven botanicals, soft Dartmoor water and pure grain alcohol at Black Friars Distillery - the oldest working distillery in England.

Sipsmith 41.6% 9

A particularly dry gin with a zesty, citrus finish. The quintessential expression of a classic, traditional London Dry Gin. Bold, complex and aromatic, but rich and balanced - perfect for a G&T.

Star of Bombay 47.5% 10

A refined gin, slow distilled in single batches at Laverstoke Distillery. It evolves the intensified traditional characteristics of a London Dry Gin with contemporary exotic notes of citrus, bergamot and Ambrette seeds.

Tanqueray London Dry 47.3% 8

A blend of the purest four-times-distilled spirit and a hand picked selection of four botanicals. A dry, crisp taste offering a uniquely balanced gin experience.

Tanqueray Rangpur 41.3% 8

Rangpur limes bring an exotic, bold flavour to the combination of juniper, coriander, bay leaves and ginger. Clean, transparent with a rich, refreshing taste, Rangpur is subtle, smooth and eminently mixable.

Whitley Neill 42% 8

Inspired by Africa with infusions of baobab fruit and cape gooseberries, giving an exotic touch to the palate. Subdued juniper and citrus notes come to the fore followed by a subtle spice and complex finish.

William Chase GB Extra Dry 40% 10

Ten fine botanicals deliver juniper, dark chocolate and citrus zest upfront on the palate, followed by notes of cinnamon, nutmeg and ginger. Full-bodied and robust with a dry finish.
