We, the farm, wish to provide you with fresh, local, seasonal food and you, the member, wish to receive a portion of our harvest. This agreement outlines our shared commitments to that relationship.

Section 1. Introducing Our CSA Farm

A. Becoming a Part of Our Farm

Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a relationship between our farm and you as our customer. Rather than simply purchasing food, our customers become “members” of this CSA farm who receive a portion of the farm’s yield.

Our meat CSA runs for 8 months. Members are responsible for showing up at the farm 2 times a month to pick up your share of frozen meat. You will generally receive 25-35lbs per month of meat. You will also receive a fresh thanksgiving turkey plus additional holiday meats. Detailed information regarding pick-up is discussed below in Section 3. Variety and quantity may vary as described below in Section 2.

For the biggest variety of meat, please join before June. No new memberships after November 1.

Our Friends of the farm CSA is another way to purchase some of the additional products that we offer the CSA members that we do not sell through are normal farm store, such as poultry, rabbit and game birds. These memberships help out with the day to day costs and keeps the cost of the products we sell down.

B. Our Growing Practices

As stewards on the land, 7th Generation Farm (the farm) is committed to provide the shareholder with a variety of high quality hormone-free meat in an environmentally friendly way throughout the Northern Colorado area.

Our animals are raised as naturally as possible for the health and well-being of the animal with no growth hormones or preventive antibiotics. Animals are free range and grass fed. Free-range animals are allowed continuous access to the outdoors during their production cycle. Grass-fed animals receive the majority of their nutrients from grass throughout their life.

C. The Products We Expect for 2020

The chart below outlines some of the meat shares we hope to deliver and when you may see them in your share. This chart is based on our best estimate, but of course may vary.

May	Beef, pork, Cornish hens
June to August	Beef, pork, chicken, lamb, duck
September to October	Beef, lamb, goat, pork, Rabbit,
November to December	Beef, pork, chicken, turkey, goat, lamb,
Undefined	Yak, Buffalo and game birds

Section 2. Picking Up Shares

You are responsible for picking up your meat shares on the first and 3rd Friday or Saturday from 100 S. 96th St, Louisville, CO 80027.

You are responsible for observing our drop site rules, which are as follows:

1. Return last week's box every week
2. Pick up your share within the timeframe stated.
3. Be respectful of our property.
4. Follow additional rules posted at your drop site regarding [parking/use of certain entrances/boxes].

If you cannot pick-up your share, you must arrange for someone else to pick it up for you. You are responsible for explaining the pick-up location and procedures to your substitute.

We take the safety of your food seriously. For your added protection, put frozen products in the freezer as soon as possible.

Section 3. Member Fees

By selling membership in advance of the growing season, CSA reduces the burden of up-front costs for the farmer. Your membership fees provide us with money to purchase feed and equipment before the season starts, and we appreciate your commitment. As a member you can also purchase meats such as; poultry, rabbit and gamebirds.

We will communicate with you by email. When you sign up, you will be added to our distribution list. Please read your email from us. We depend on being able to communicate important information such as necessary changes to your distribution schedule or to our farm events.

By signing below, I agree to purchase the membership share indicated in Section 4. I understand that, although unlikely, the farm may change parts of this agreement related to production and distribution from time to time. I understand that they will contact me via email in advance of any changes to this agreement.
