Figure 1. Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri

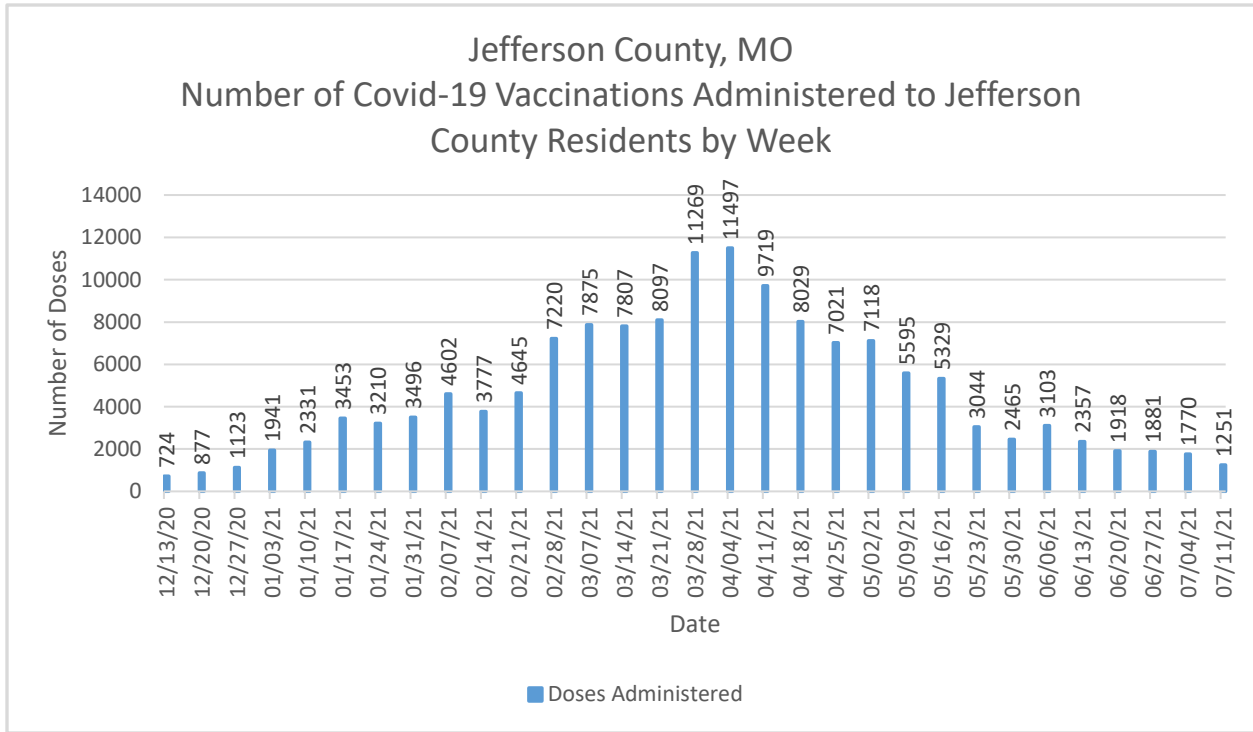
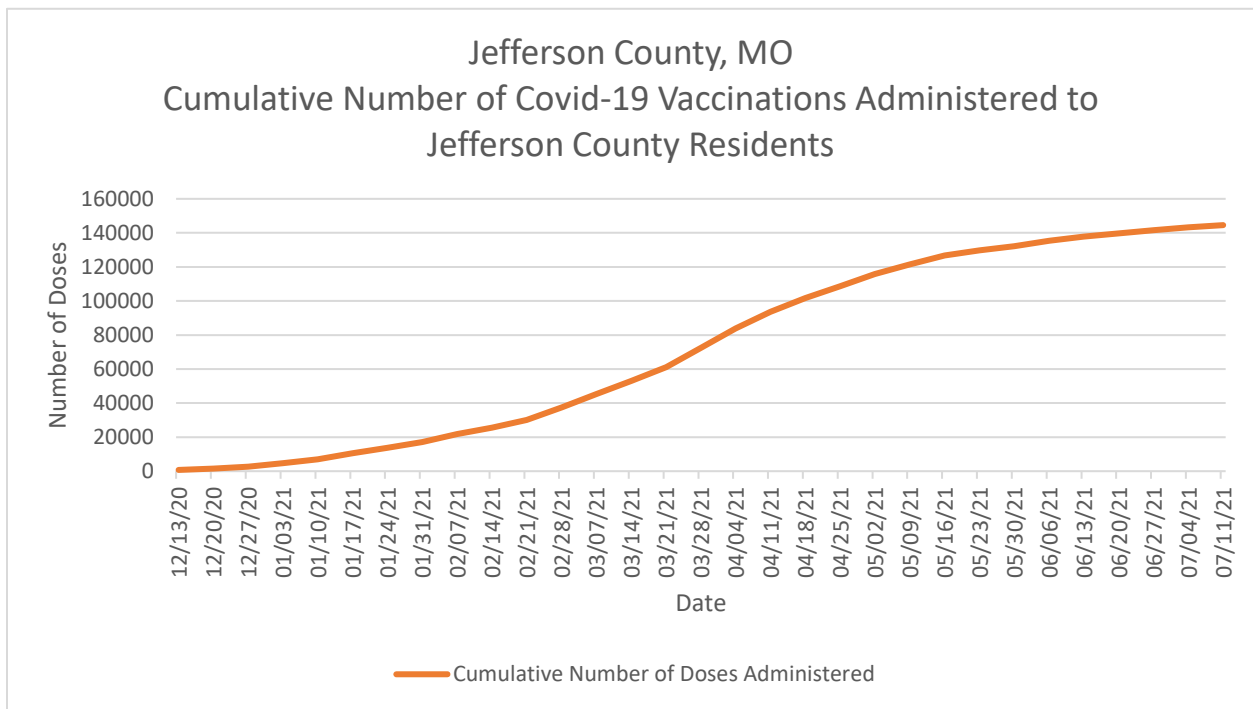


Figure 2. Cumulative Number of Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri



Covid-19 Vaccine Breakthrough Cases*,
Jefferson County, Missouri

- 68,986 Jefferson County Residents have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as of July 16, 2021.
- Vaccine breakthrough infections have been reported in 43 (.06%) Jefferson County residents.
- 4 (0.006%) people with breakthrough infections were known to be hospitalized.
- 2 (0.003%) of the vaccine breakthrough infections were reported as asymptomatic.

*CDC defines a breakthrough case as a U.S. resident who has SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen detected on a respiratory specimen collected ≥ 14 days after completing the primary series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
