Figure 1. Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri

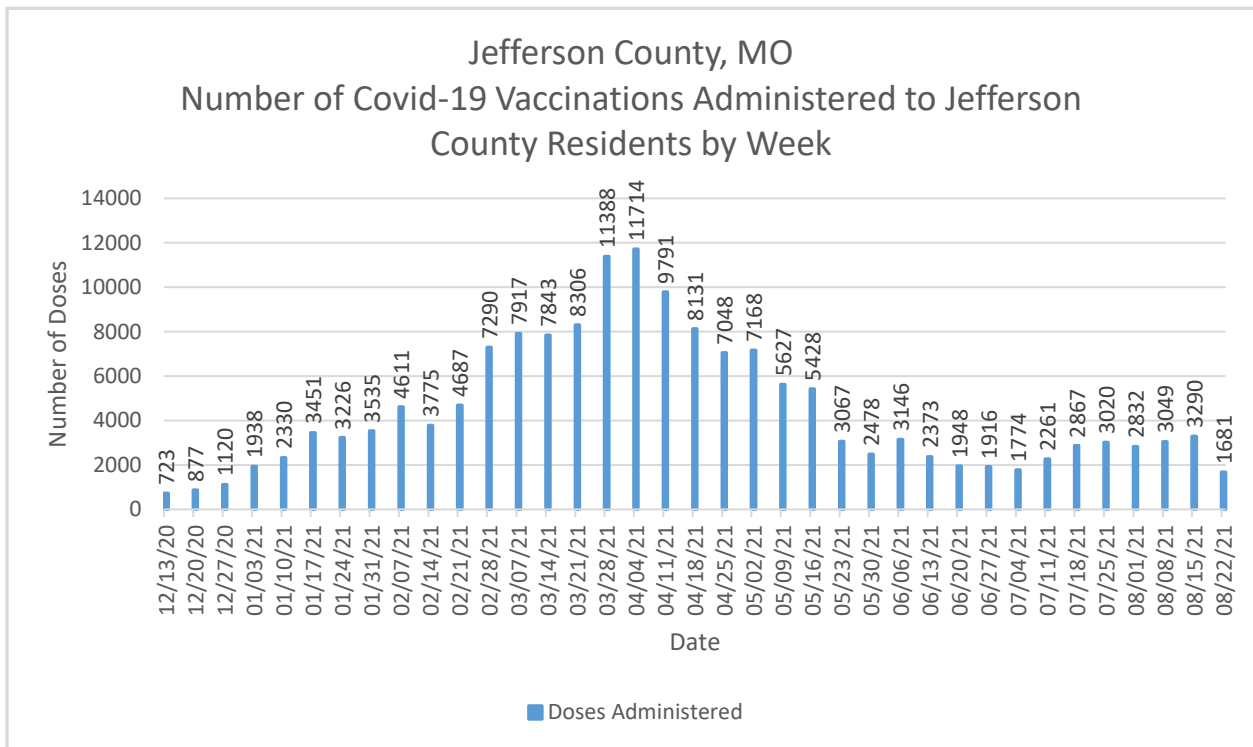
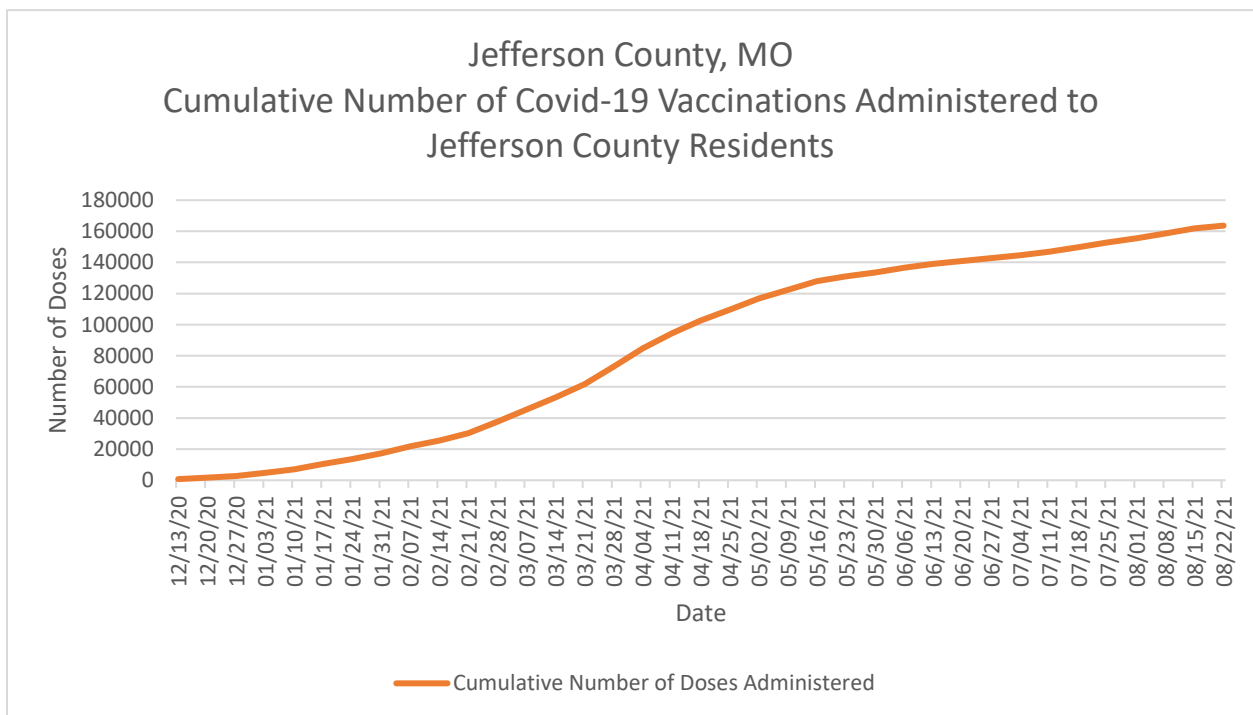


Figure 2. Cumulative Number of Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri



Covid-19 Vaccine Breakthrough Cases*,
Jefferson County, Missouri

- 77,593 Jefferson County Residents have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as of August 27, 2021.
- Since breakthrough case reporting began, 5 (0.005%) people were known to be hospitalized.
- During Week 34, 577 new COVID-19 cases were reported. Of these 577 new cases, **86.3% were unvaccinated** and 13.7% were vaccinated (breakthrough cases).

*CDC defines a breakthrough case as a U.S. resident who has SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen detected on a respiratory specimen collected ≥ 14 days after completing the primary series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
