




Figure 1. Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri





Covid-19 Vaccine Breakthrough Cases*, Jefferson County, Missouri

- 80,340 Jefferson County Residents have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as of September 10, 2021.
- Since breakthrough case reporting began, 7 (0.009%) fully vaccinated people were known to be hospitalized.
- During Week 36, 729 new COVID-19 cases were reported. Of these 729 new cases, **81.1% were unvaccinated** and 18.9% were vaccinated (breakthrough cases).

*CDC defines a breakthrough case as a U.S. resident who has SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen detected on a respiratory specimen collected ≥14 days after completing the primary series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
