Figure 1. Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri





Figure 2. Cumulative Number of Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri



Covid-19 Vaccine Breakthrough Cases*, Jefferson County, Missouri

- 81,655 Jefferson County Residents have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as of September 17, 2021.
- During Week 37, 770 new COVID-19 cases were reported. Of these 770 new cases, **81.7% were unvaccinated** and 18.3% were vaccinated (breakthrough cases).

*CDC defines a breakthrough case as a U.S. resident who has SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen detected on a respiratory specimen collected ≥14 days after completing the primary series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
