Figure 1. Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri





Figure 2. Cumulative Number of Covid-19 Vaccinations Administered to Jefferson County Residents by Week, Jefferson County, Missouri



## Covid-19 Vaccine Breakthrough Cases\*, Jefferson County, Missouri

- 95,627 Jefferson County Residents have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 as of October 4, 2021.
- During Week 39, 603 new COVID-19 cases were reported. Of these 603 new cases, **81.9% were unvaccinated** and 18.1% were vaccinated (breakthrough cases).

\*CDC defines a breakthrough case as a U.S. resident who has SARS-CoV-2 RNA or antigen detected on a respiratory specimen collected ≥14 days after completing the primary series of an FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccine.
