## DELMARVA-DC RESPONDS TO DISASTER RELIEF

---

Churches across Delmarva-DC responded to the recent barrage of natural disasters with funds, supplies, and on-site assistance. More than \$100,000 has been contributed to assist victims in Texas, Florida, and the Caribbean. To highlight a few . . .

- Ebenezer Church of God (Hyattsville, MD/Pastor Oliver Subryan) shipped 7 containers of supplies to various Caribbean islands over a seven-week period.
- Riverside Community Church (Aberdeen, MD/Pastor Jason Evans) sent a team to Puerto Rico with more than 200 boxes of clothing, as well as medical, personal hygiene, and cleaning supplies.
- Pastor Dan Southern (Seaford, DE) led a team to the Houston, TX area to help with demolition and re-building efforts.
- Delmarva-DC churches purchased more than 30 semi-truck loads of water and supplies for Texas and Florida.
- An anonymous donor sent 6 high-capacity generators to the British Virgin Islands.

## CHURCHES INVOLVED IN NATURAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT

At the 2017 Delmarva-DC camp meeting, Bishop Rice and Dr. Michael D. Reynolds (Chicago, IL) introduced Natural Church Development (NCD) - focusing on church health. Since then, Bishop Rice has hosted 2 Zoom meetings with Dr. Reynolds and pastors interested in NCD. To date, 7 Delmarva-DC churches and pastors are participating at some level of involvement with the NCD process of assessing and addressing issues related to church health. The Regional Council approved a cooperative plan to assist local churches in sharing the cost of NCD assessments and coaching.
