

# **SWID LOCK-IN**

## *Frequently Asked Questions*

### ***What is SWID Lock-In?***

SWID Lock-In is an overnight event held at the Rose Hulman Sports & Recreation Center in Terre Haute.

### ***What age is allowed to attend?***

Any student who is currently in 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade is allowed to attend.

### ***Why should I go?***

GREAT question! Glad you asked. We believe there are many reasons. Here are a few:

- It offers an opportunity to encounter God in a powerful opening service. Every student will be encouraged to take the next step in their faith journey; whether it is the 1<sup>st</sup> step or the 21<sup>st</sup> step.
- It offers an opportunity to meet new friends and develop friendships with those around the district.
- It's just an all-around FUN night! Basketball, volleyball, dodgeball, pool, and more!

### ***How much does it cost?***

Lock-In costs \$20 for students. The cost includes pizza and pop after the opening service.

### ***Do adults need to pay?***

Yes and No. If an adult wants to eat pizza, they pay \$4. If the adult isn't planning to eat pizza, they owe nothing.

### ***Will I need more money during the event?***

There will not be any need for extra money during the event. There will be a concession stand. This would require extra money, but is not necessary.

### ***What time does it start and end?***

Doors open at 10:15 PM Eastern Time on Friday night. A fun pre-show begins at 10:30 PM ET. Opening service begins at 11:00 PM ET. Lock-In wraps up at 6:00 AM ET Saturday morning.

### ***How do I get there?***

Each church/participant is responsible for getting to Rose Hulman on their own. **HOWEVER**, if you need a ride and cannot find a way there, PLEASE let us know. We have a number of churches who will be driving church vans from all over the district. Most of them will have an extra seat or two and would LOVE to provide you transportation there and back. Let us know and we can work that out...no problem!

### ***Will there be a quiet room for van drivers to sleep in?***

Yes, there will be a quiet room for van drivers to sleep. We do not guarantee comfort or snore-free experience in there. ☺ There are also a number of hotels in Terre Haute that could be utilized.

### ***Will there be a lock-in nurse?***

Yes. The nurse's station location will be communicated during the leader's meeting.

### ***Are there special rules for the swimming time?***

Yes. Swimming will be from 1-5AM; open swim time for everyone. All girls must wear a one-piece suit or wear a t-shirt.

### ***What are the rules for the volleyball tournament?***

Each team will sign up when they arrive at the lock-in. All teams will be 6-10 people with at least 3 girls and 3 guys on each team. You can only play for 1 team. It will be single elimination with the best of 3 sets. All points will be based on the rally point system to 25, except on 3<sup>rd</sup> sets will be 15.

### ***What are the rules for the 3 on 3 basketball tournament?***

Each team must sign up when they arrive at the lock-in. This is for both guys and gals. Your team does not have to be mixed if you choose. There will be 3 separate divisions (Jr. High, High School, and College and Career). Each team will be 3 to 4 players. If you choose to mix the age groups of your team, your team will compete in the division of your oldest player. You can only play for 1 team and in only 1 division.
