



2015 Domaine Girard Pinot Noir Pays d'Oc

Pinot Noir is rarely successful in the Languedoc. However, the higher altitude of this vineyard permits more even ripening of the grapes. A terrific value in Pinot Noir that is true to form.

VARIETIES: 100% Pinot Noir

CLASSIFICATION: Pays d'Oc IGP

VINEYARDS: From the southeast facing "Font-Cailhau" vineyard at an altitude of 300 metres.

VINEYARD SOILS: Clay / Silt / Gravel

FARMING: Sustainable

WINEMAKING: Manual harvest, in small flat containers to protect the grapes from crushing. 100% destemmed. Maceration 4 -5 days at low temperatures (8-10°C) Fermentation is traditional, with 2 to 3 daily punchings of the cap. Gentle pressing.

AGING: Stainless Steel tank for 5-8 months

RECOMMENDED CONSUMPTION: Upon release and over next 3 years
