

## 2014 Château Peyronneau Saint-Émilion Grand Cru

The 12 hectares of vineyards of Château Tour Peyronneau sit on hillsides in the communes of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens & Libourne. The more gravelly soils of Château Tour Peyronneau provide silky/mineral notes, often redolent of warm stone and floral notes.

VARIETIES: 85% Merlot / 15% Cabernet Franc

CLASSIFICATION: Saint-Émilion Grand Cru AOC

VINEYARDS: 12 hectares in communes of Saint-Sulpice de Faleyrens & Libourne Vine age: 32+ years

VINEYARD SOILS: Clay, Sand & Gravel soils

FARMING: Organic

WINEMAKING: De-stemmed, triage with optical sorting machine. Fermentation in stainless steel tanks between 28-36 days.

AGING: 1/3 of the wine (from clay heavy soils) spends 12 months in new French oak. 2/3 in tank.

RECOMMENDED CONSUMPTION: Upon release and over next 15 years
