Parent/Guardian Contract

The success of the Ashmont Nursery School as a creative and educational enterprise for two-, three-, four- and five-year-old children depends on the commitment, involvement, financial responsibility, and cooperation of families. Choosing to send your child to this school means accepting responsibilities and carrying out duties which are routinely handled in other organizations by paid administrators.

A parent/guardian from one family works with teachers caring for the children, helping with activities and assisting with clean-up chores each day. Parents/guardians will also attend general meetings, join standing committees, and participate in regularly-scheduled work and general maintenance programs.

Please consider each of the following requirements before you sign this contract. The agreement will be included in your family file for future reference.

1. Classroom work is required on a regularly-scheduled basis (approximately once every 4-6 weeks). Teachers should be notified 48 hours in advance of any substitution, except in case of illness or emergency. Each parent/guardian is responsible for finding his/her own substitute.
2. All parents/guardians are required to participate in one weekend workday during the school year as well as summer work weekends on an assigned-as-needed basis.
3. One parent/guardian from each family is required to attend the orientation meeting in May/June, and three general meetings (fall, winter, and spring) during the school year.
4. One parent/guardian from each family is required to join at least one standing committee or fulfill one of the ongoing "jobs"; all parents/guardians are also required to participate and assist in fundraising activities and events.
5. Parents/guardians are expected to familiarize themselves with the ANS Handbook and are responsible for following the policies and procedures contained therein.
6. Parents/guardians are required to pay the full monthly tuition fee for each enrolled student in a timely manner. In the event of a child's voluntary withdrawal or decrease in schedule prior to the end of the school year, the family will pay the tuition due in the month that notice is given as well as for the following one calendar month. The one month deposit that serves as June tuition is non-refundable.
