Continued Transformation in the New Year

Construction at 2506 Jefferson Avenue

In early November, the Economic Development Authority [EDA] issued a notice to proceed to Ritchie-Curbow Construction Company, Inc. for rehabilitation of 2506 Jefferson Avenue. 2506 Jefferson Avenue is the future location of the co-working space identified as a community need in the Transformation Plan for the Marshall-Ridley Choice Neighborhood.

Purpose of the Co-working Space

When complete, the co-working space will provide low-cost, shared office space and business support services in the Southeast Community to assist small and new businesses starting in the neighborhood. Small businesses and entrepreneurs can obtain technical assistance, attend business management workshops and receive expert advice on various topics including: business planning, industry research, accounting and capital sources.

Funding & Schedule for the Project

The \$1.8 million rehabilitation project is supported by a \$480,000 Industrial Revitalization Fund Grant from the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development [DHCD]. Ritchie-Curbow is preparing the building for the rehabilitation work and securing necessary approvals, with more visible work scheduled to begin in January. The completion of the project is anticipated in the Summer of 2020.

Co-working Space Operation

The co-working space will be operated by the EDA and a third party entity will be hired to manage the site. Programming and marketing will be provided by various entities.
