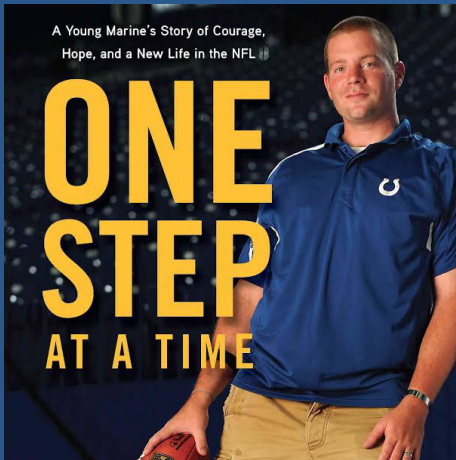

Like many of us, the events of September 11, 2001, changed Josh's life forever. Two years after that fateful "day, something clicked inside Josh and he decided to enlist in the U.S. Marine Corps. At 27 years of age, he was off to boot camp and was later deployed to Fallujah, Iraq.



Then, it all went black.

A bomb exploded under the vehicle Josh was riding in. He woke up five days later to the realization that he had lost two friends and both of his legs in the blast. He spent two years of extensive rehabilitation. With 32 pins in his hip and a 6-inch screw holding his pelvis together.

Today, Corporal Josh Bleill is a walking, talking symbol of hope, using his story to motivate and inspire others. Even with all he's been through, Josh doesn't just believe in the American dream.
