Tuition & Payment Policies
2023-2024 Academic Year

Deposits:

The deposit is due upon signing the contract, is non-refundable, and will be deducted from tuition due. The deposit is 15% of the tuition due for the school year. Families choosing to cancel a contract must do so in writing by April 1, 2023, and the deposit is retained by the School without exception. The deposit can be paid by check or [online](#). International families can pay by check or [Flywire](#).

Payment Options:

When signing your contract, you will choose from the following payment options:

Regular Plan:	Full tuition is due July 1, 2023
Deferred Plan:	60% of tuition is due July 1, 2023 40% of tuition is due December by 1, 2023 , plus \$500 fee if late
Monthly Plan:	Monthly bill through Smart Tuition plus \$50 annual fee 9 month, 10 month, or 12 month plan* (<i>*starts in June 2023</i>) All plans must be paid off by May 15, 2024

Tuition Refund Policy:

If a student withdraws and/or is dismissed for any reason before the completion of the contract term, there is no refund.

Failure to Make Payments:

In the event that the undersigned for and on behalf of the student fails to make payments per the schedule set out herein, or fails to pay their monthly bill for student charges within thirty (30) days, a late fee equal to 1.5% of the balance due will be added to the account. In addition, La Lumiere School will withhold the student's grades and transcripts of credit and cancel his/her charge privileges on campus. The School reserves the right to immediately turn the account over to an attorney or collection agency for collection.
