
we provide homeless individuals diagnosed with disabling HIV/AIDS with housing and medical services




### OUTCOMES

### ABOUT

Catholic Charities Peter Claver Community provides permanent housing placement and comprehensive nursing and support services to care to formerly homeless San Francisco clients who are very low income, who have disabling HIV/AIDS, with co-occurring major psychiatric and/or substance abuse disorders. Opened in 1985, the program marked one of the earliest attempts by any organization to aggressively serve those sick and dying from HIV/AIDS.

To minimize the utilization of hospital emergency rooms, crisis services, and other publicly-funded health systems, the staff is able to address most problems on-site. Registered Nurses, Certified Nursing Assistants, a Licensed Marriage Family Therapist, and a Case Manager assist clients in increasing adherence to complex medical regimes, avert acute medical/psychiatric emergencies and facilitate the care coordination among multiple health providers.

### SERVICES

- Nursing care and Certified Nursing Assistant supervision 24/7
- On-site social work case management and medication management
- Coordination of care with medical providers and transportation to appointments
- Mental health and support group services
- Hospice Care
- Customized menus and three meals provided daily
- Collaboration with the other HIV service providers to ensure that residents have all their medical, psychosocial and spiritual needs met

### CHANGE MODEL

#### The Need

- Men and women affected by HIV/AIDS are experiencing

  - Substance abuse

- Housing
- Medical psychosocial case management
