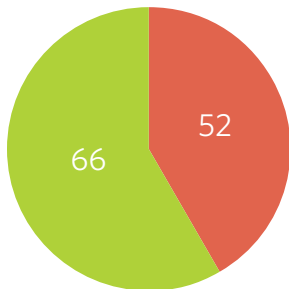

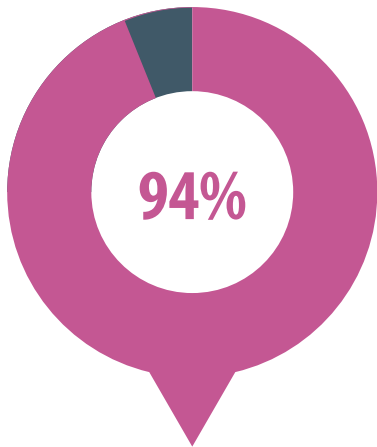

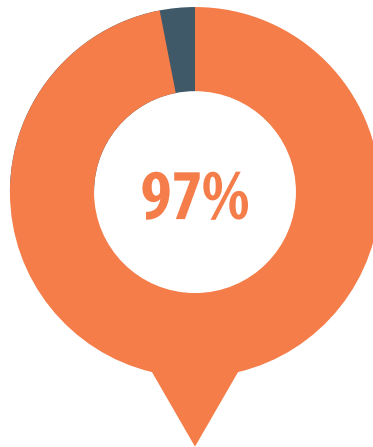

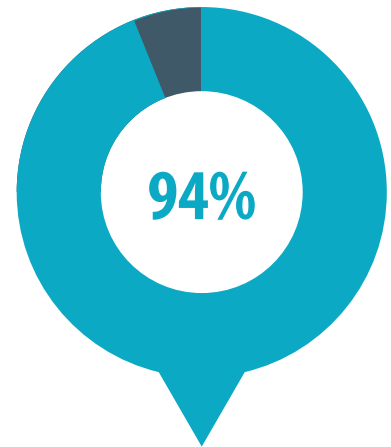

### ABOUT

Catholic Charities SF HOME provides homeless and low-income families with ongoing monthly rental subsidies accompanied by intensive case management services in order to rapidly transition homeless families into housing and to prevent low-income families from becoming homeless. SF HOME serves families through case management to pursue opportunities so they may either increase their income or remove barriers to permanent affordable housing.

The program provides strengths-based case management and comprehensive supportive services in a home-based setting to aid families toward independent living. Through SF HOME, clients are able to locate and maintain safe, permanent housing, receive guidance in meeting educational and professional goals, learn self-sufficiency skills, organize their expenses and manage money, and develop solid relationships both in their families and the community. SF HOME is a partnership with Compass Family Services and the Human Services Agency of San Francisco.
