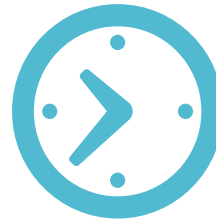

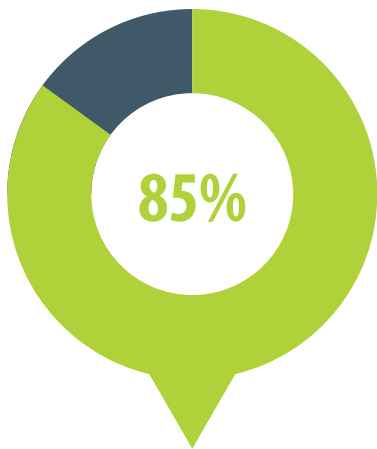

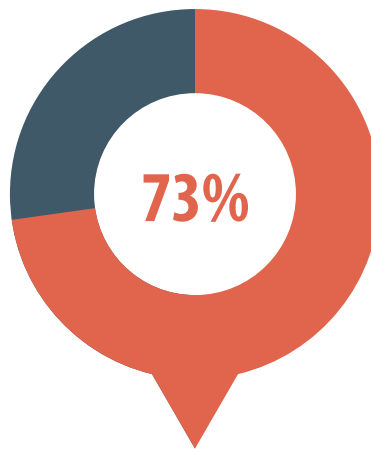

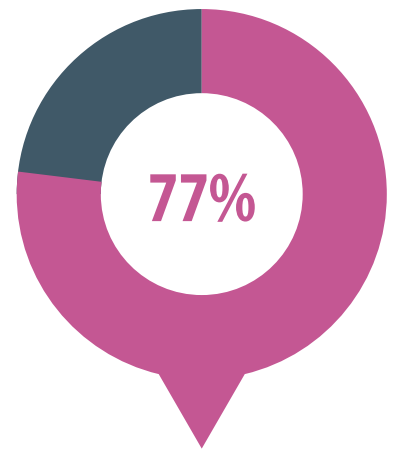

### ABOUT

Catholic Charities Treasure Island Supportive Housing promotes the self-sufficiency and independence of formerly homeless families. Clients are supported through an array of services that are designed to assist families with the challenges of accessing and retaining safe, secure, and permanent housing and to achieve residential, economic, and personal stability. Permanent, subsidized supportive housing is provided to formerly homeless families where the head of household has one or more special needs which may include mental health challenges, disabling HIV/AIDS, or history of substance abuse.

Treasure Island Supportive Housing offers supportive services in conjunction with housing including case management, substance abuse counseling and employment assistance. Clients may also receive referrals to outside agencies. Treasure Island Supportive Housing also collaborates with other organizations to provide community activities for children and families.

### SERVICES

- Housing for 100 families (300+ individuals)
- Case management, counseling and crisis intervention
- Substance abuse and mental health assessment and referrals
- Employment and educational services
- Parenting and interpersonal lifeskills workshops
- Weekly food pantry to supplement groceries
- Van for client transportation
