Hello 2020!

We rang out the old year and celebrated the new with encouraging results from Wave Life Sciences' PRECISION-HD2 clinical trial, one of the three clinical trials currently underway aimed at the genetic source of Huntington's disease. In an analysis comparing all patients treated with multiple doses of WVE-120102 to placebo, a statistically significant reduction in mutant huntingtin protein was observed in cerebrospinal fluid. What an exciting way to kick off the new decade!



Next month, we will highlight all three of these clinical trials. Research is making a difference!
