SUMMARY

This position requires gas and diesel mechanic work. Must be able to work under pressure and be willing to work long hours when needed.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Including the following (other duties may be documented and assigned by management and some duties may not apply dependent upon the requirements of the position at each specific Tarter site and/or the strengths of the employee and the needs of the company):

1. Perform minor and major repair of gas and diesel machinery and equipment including: semi and log trucks, fork lifts, skidders, tractors, dozers, 4-wheelers, and other equipment as required.
2. Troubleshoot and diagnose mechanical problems in gas and diesel machinery and equipment.
3. Perform preventative maintenance on gas and diesel machinery and equipment.
4. Maintain records of scheduled and unscheduled maintenance procedures.
5. Read and interpret equipment manuals and work orders to perform required maintenance procedures.
6. Use testing instruments such as handheld computers, motor analyzers, chassis charts, and pressure gauges.

Knowledge, skills & abilities: Must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Effective interpersonal, organizational, verbal and written communication skills required. This position performs job duties in an ethical and professional manner. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
