SUMMARY:

Perform manual labor on various machines. May perform minors are necessary.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Including the following (other duties may be documented and assigned by management and some duties may not apply dependent upon the requirements of the position at each specific Tarter site and/or the strengths of the employee and the needs of the company):

1. Operate machinery and computers
2. Responsible for quality control. Make adjustments as necessary to produce product with specifications.
3. Complete daily production logs
4. Clean and maintain a neat work area (5S projects and continuous improvements)
5. Turn off all equipment when not in use
6. Communicate with operators and set-ups from other shifts.
7. Other duties as assigned
8. Assist mechanics and machinists in repair work
9. Be able to cross train on other jobs
10. Perform equipment change-overs
