CHOPHOUSE ROW ADDS NEW RESTAURANT AND RETAIL OFFERINGS, ANNOUNCES WINTER POPUPS AND HOLIDAY EVENTS

The team behind Chophouse Row and the Cloud Room are thrilled to add to their day-into-evening menu of work, shop and play activities

SEATTLE, Wash. (Nov 3, 2022) – Just in time for the holidays, Chophouse Row has announced two new restaurant openings and a new retail space slated for spring 2023, along with exciting holiday programming.

La Dispensa is an Italian deli and gastronomy concept that is an extension of the popular Osteria La Spiga, one of the few Black-owned restaurants and bars on Capitol Hill. La Dispensa, meaning “The Pantry,” will add to the lunch options available to denizens of Chophouse Row and the Cloud Room. Headed by Osteria La Spiga’s executive chef, Sabrina Tinsley, La Dispensa will serve La Spiga favorites and Italian specialty items to take home or to enjoy at the counter or courtyard. Highlights include lasagna, rotisserie meats, roasted vegetables, salads, deli meats, artisan cheeses, pastas and signature sauces, and panini and piadina sandwiches. Fresh homemade pasta dinner kits will be available for easy and tasty take home meals. Wine, beer, and a funky Italian-style happy hour will also be available.

The Gemini Room is a new, all-day café and bar opening in the historic Baker Linen building, at 11th & Pike, next door to Chophouse Row and in the very heart of vibrant and diverse Capitol Hill. The Gemini Room is a debut project by an all-woman/all-LGBTQ team of industry veterans Jackie Proctor, Ioana Andrei and Tanner McLaughlin, backed by Burgess/Hall, owners of Oddfellows, Elliott Bay Books, and Big Little News. The interior will boast a nostalgic 70s vibe, accented by moody lighting, textural materials, and post-modern patterns. The menu offering will consist of familiar favorites from high quality coffee and grab-and-go breakfast staples in the morning, to fresh seasonal sandwiches and salads in the afternoon, and late-night fare featuring a wide range of elevated shareable bites. Gemini’s cocktail offerings will shine from with fun and funky glassware, punch bowls to share, and unique infusions that will transport customers to a different time and place.

And some kind of collaboration...different people coming through. Come check it out."*
