Biographical / Historical Note

General Claire Lee Chennault was the notable leader of the Flying Tigers in China during World War II. He died in 1958 after battling lung cancer at the Oschner Foundation Hospital in New Orleans. His second wife, Anna Chennault, was with him during that time.

Scope and Content

This collection contains letters written to Chennault (1893-1958) while hospitalized with lung cancer at Ochsner hospital. Includes copies of letters written by his second wife, Anna Chan, to various individuals during her stay in New Orleans with her husband, several letters regarding Madame Chiang Kai-Shek's visit to Chennault in the hospital, some letters advising Chennault of "miracle" cures for the disease, and others from men who served under Chennault's command.
