Collected paper ephemera, originally intended to be pasted into a scrapbook, documenting donor's school years as a student at Merrick Elementary School, Mc Main High School, and Louisiana State University. Included in the collection are issues of *Echoes of McMain*, published by McMain High School; a wedding invitation, invitations to sorority parties, football game tickets, a report card, a menu for a dinner aboard the vessel, *T. E. S. Antigua*.

--receipt for airplane ticket [with envelope in the name of Barbara Keagy.] Eastern Airlines, Atlanta to New Orleans, \$24.84, issued to Mrs. Keagy. Aug 10, 1945.

--pamphlet. Informational brochure, Ursuline Academy. Includes information re the school's policies, curriculum, tuition fees, a list of the wardrobe necessary for resident students, and photographs. c. 1945.

--brochure. The Hummingbird [L & N railroad] "the modern all-coach train between Cincinnati and New Orleans." Nov. 17, 1946.

--child's season ticket #0185, [Tulane University football games?], sold to Barbara Keagy. Season 1946.

--report card issued to Barbara Keagy, New Orleans Public Schools, eighth grade. 1946-47.

--program and typewritten history of the January 1947 graduating class, Eighth Grade, Merrick school. Verso of typewritten pages: letterhead of Dr. W. O. Keagy, dentist, Canal Street, New Orleans. Jan 24, 1947.

--invitation issued by Dr. W. O. Keagy and the officers and directors of the Joy Theatre to attend the formal opening "of the South's newest and most modern motion picture theatre." Presenting "Lover Come Back," starring George Brent and Lucille Ball. New Orleans, Feb 6, 1947.

--admit ticket. Pi Alpha Kappa Weiner [sic] Roast. Apr 12, 1947.

--ticket. Gym Night, Mc Main Auditorium. April 18, 1947.

--program. Gym Night, [Mc Main High School?]. April, 1947.

--receipt for fees issued by McMain Summer High School to Barbara Keagy. June 9, 1947.

--Western Union telegram notice issued to Barbara Keagy. Includes verso notation: "Why don't you stay home once in awhile, if you want me to come back[.] [T]ell the girl to have it [delivered]. Aug 22, 1947.

--admit card #9932, "*Whaddaya Know!*" [Radio] Quiz show, WWL. University Room, Roosevelt Hotel. New Orleans, c. 1947.

--partially canceled admission ticket, tennis, Audubon Park, issued to Barbara Keagy. c. 1947.

--invitation [with envelope] issued by Pi Alpha Kappa sorority to attend a Summer Formal. The Jung Roof. June 10, 1948.

--invitation issued by Theta Delta Gamma Sorority to attend their Summer Formal. The Jung Roof. Jun 15, 1948.

--program. Football game, Slidell vs. Isidore Newman High. Slidell High Stadium. Oct. 1, 1948.

--coupon, mimeographed for bus trip to Southern Championship football game, Fortier vs. Istrouma. Dec 4, 1948.

- invitation issued by Alpha Xi Delta Sorority to attend the Rose Dance, honoring the pledge class of 1950-51. Feb 17, 1950.
- hand-made paper doll cut out [invitation?], Theta Delta Gamma [sorority?]. c. 1950.
- Christmas [present?] name tag, "Wishing you a Merry Christmas, Bud," from Godchaux's, New Orleans. Includes image of the store. c. 1950.
