Quinta do Regueiro

Sub-Region of Monção & Melgaço from the Vinho Verde DOC

The first vine was planted by the Rodrigues family in 1988 as growers, using at the time cuts from a two very old vines with more than 200 year of age, resent research discover “this is a unique indigenous Alvarinho clone” producing top quality award winning wines by the hand of the son Paulo Rodrigues, that in 1999 started to produce their own label Quinta do Regueiro. The 10 hectares estate is planted with 100% Alvarinho grape, witch 90% are from the “indigenous” clone, up in small vine parcels located in “socialcos” at about 850 meters altitude above the sea, mainly on granitic soils that makes this estate a magic place with a unique “Terroir”.

Trás-os-Montes

Mont'Alegre 'by Francisco Gonçalves'

Situated in the North of Portugal, the region of Trás-os-Montes reveals itself amidst hills and steep valleys in a wide extension.

This is a unique region with special characteristics.

Mont'Alegre (T/M) has its old vineyards with centenarian grape variety at a 650 to 750 metres above sea level with a 'small plot' vineyard at 1000 meters where the wines stage. This house used to be Francisco Gonçalves grandmother, 'avó Xiquinha' where he was born. Francisco studied at the University of Trás-os-Montes e Alto Douro that he began his dedication to the studies of the vine and wine and started the discovery of better techniques to express the unique notes of each grape variety. Francisco's criteria taken into account for this project, were essentially; altitude, sun exposure, climate and soil composition.

Throughout his career, he was responsible for the creation and development of numerous award-winning wines from the regions of Douro, Rias Baixas and Ribera Del Douro

Vinilourenço is situated in a small village Poço do Canto, Meda municipality, in the heart of Douro Superior. Since the 80's Vinilourenço's Family has been acquiring various properties in Douro Superior, currently has 45 hectares of vineyards, spread over the counties of Meda and Vila Nova de Foz Côa. The various location plots situated in Poço do Canto, Vale da Teja and Pocinho comes with diversity of climate, altitude between 160 to 700 mtrs with soils, shale in the lowlands and shale/granite in the highest lands. This different locations combined with very old vines and a well-planned harvesting give a huge diverse and versatility of the wine styles.

Quinta da Boavista

Quinta da Boavista was included in the first ever demarcation of the Douro demarcated region, ordered by Portugal's powerful first minister the Marquis of Pombal, in 1757. The estate's main house was a favourite abode of Baron Joseph James Forrester, the illustrious wine-maker, map-maker, painter and historic defender of best practises in the Port industry.

Half of the 80 hectares of this estate is under vine and all its vineyards have the top "A" classification. In short, Boavista is a jewel among the Douro's quintas.

Álvaro de Castro - Quinta de Sães & Quinta da Pellada

The “Master of Dão region” Álvaro Castro and his daughter Maria are widely acknowledged as being the leading producers in Portugal’s Dão region, known as the Burgundy of Portugal because of the elegance of its wines. Álvaro was a civil engineer who inherited the family property in 1980. The estate has been in existence since the 16th Century, but since started to make wines under Álvaro Castro, the rise of the estate has been phenomenal. When Douro winemaking legend Dirk van der Niepoort decided to make a wine, blending the power of the Douro with the finesse of Dão, there was only one duo of winemakers in Dão he trusted enough: Álvaro and Maria Castro. Their wines are sustainably grown on granite soils, high up in the mountains and the results have a real finesse and elegance.

The grandfather Martinho, a farmer from Mogofores, produced red wine back in the early 1920's and in 1960's, the father Manuel took charge on modernizing and expanding. In mid-1990's started testing for the first time in that meantime in the region, new varieties planted. The vineyards are located in two proprieties: 110 hectares Quinta de S. Mateus and 60 hectares Quinta do Vale de Azar. The soils are mostly sandy-clay, with small calcareous areas.

The first Campolargo wines resulted from 2000 crop, although the new cellar was only built in 2004.

Villa Oeiras

From Carcavelos DOC was once world famous for its fortified wines. During the 18th and 19th centuries Carcavelos fortified wine was produced and rigorously championed by, among others, the formidable Portuguese statesman D. Sebastião José de Carvalho e Melo, the Marquis of Pombal and Count of Oeiras. The Marquis of Pombal's 135 hectare estate in Oeiras, a "pearl of the baroque" era, is currently a partnership between the Municipality of Oeiras and Ministry of Agriculture. Their goal is to revive the region's fortified wine tradition through the **Villa Oeiras** (formerly Conde de Oeiras) brand. The grape varieties are Arinto, Galego Dourado and Ratinho (white) and Castelão and Trincadeira (red). Currently, around 130,000 litres of wine dating from 1991 is being matured in this cellar and the original 18th century barrel room. Since 2007, the wines have been made by Tiago Correia, the aim is to produce an expression of Carcavelos which, true to tradition, will evolve over many decades in bottle.

Dona Maria – Julio Bastos

Dona Maria is located in Estremoz, North Alentejo at 450 meters altitude since the 18th century, it was only in 1988 that its current owner Julio Bastos started sell the wines produced here. In 1992 Júlio Bastos sold 50% of the Quinta do Carmo to the Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite). It was then that the old winery was transferred from Quinta de Dona Maria, or Quinta do Carmo, to the Estate called Herdade das Carvalhas, which belongs since then to that company. Never having given up on the idea of again producing his own wine, Júlio Bastos then decided to sell his shares in the Quinta do Carmo, and started this new project, Dona Maria wines. In 2001 and 2002 bought a vineyard which is now over 50 years old and whose genetic heritage is over 150 years old, the cellar has been equipped with the most modern technology, maintaining the marble “lagares”, where the traditional foot treading method is still used nowadays. Since the beginning of this project the Dona Maria wines have been recognized, not only by the public but also by opinion leaders.

Governed by English law, we may from time to time alter the conditions of sale without further notice.

1. Application

These Conditions apply to all sales of wine by Portal Wines and Spirits Ltd [PW&S Ltd] to any customer (a 'Customer') and apply in place of and prevail over any terms or conditions put forward by any Customer.

2. Wines & Prices

- a. Subject to Condition 3 below and any other discounts that ['PW&S'] may, in its sole discretion, agree with any customer, the price of all wine supplied by ['PW&S'] to a Customer shall be as set out in [PW&S] price list in force at the date of the invoice for such wine.
- b. All orders must be for full cases and a minimum of 4.5 litres (6 bottles of 750ml or equivalent) for Duty Delivery Paid ['DDP'] prices. Any other specific order request must be pre agreed by ['PW&S'] and might incur in extra cost.
- c. *Availability. All products are sold subject to availability.*
- d. All 'DDP' prices include custom & excise duty and insurance costs but are exclusive of any applicable value added or any other sales tax.
- e. 'IBD' prices can be quoted on request and include insurance costs but are exclusive of custom & excise duty and any applicable value added or any other sales tax.
- f. We reserve the right to change any prices at any time due to; Producers price increase, Currency exchange rates, increase of carriage fees and any tax's adjustments. However PW&S ensures that will always make all efforts to minimise all price increase and inform ['the Customer'] right way in righting.

3. Discount

- a. A collection discount of 40 pence per bottle on 'DDP' prices will apply to an order if a Customer agrees, at the time of making an order, to collect the wine from ['PW&S'] account at 'London City Bond, Barking' warehouse.
- b. A transfer discount of 30 pence per bottle on 'IBD' prices will apply to an order if a Customer agrees, at the time of making the order, that the wine be transferred to an area in 'London City Bond Barking' Customer account.

4. Terms of Payment

- a. Usual Procedure
Other than as otherwise agreed in writing by ['PW&S'] or as set out in Condition 4_ (b) below, ['PW&S'] invoices are payable on delivery by the Customer of the wine which is the subject of such invoice.
- b. * Credit Account Customers.
A Customer may, if it supplies a suitable bank reference, apply to ['PW&S'] to become a credit account customer (a 'Credit Account Customer'). ['PW&S'] reserves the right to refuse any such application at its sole discretion, invoices issued to Credit Account Customers are payable within 30 days of the date of such invoice.
- c. Any other extension on time of payment [an 'Extension Time of Payment'] can be consider and most be pre agreed in writing by ['PW&S'] and the Costumer before placing the order by the Costumer.
- d. 'Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998'. 'Interest' shall accrue at a rate of 2% above the base rate of ['PW&S'] bank from time to time on any due but unpaid sums owed by a Customer to ['PW&S'].
Any such interest shall accrue from the date of non-payment until payment is received by ['PW&S'] and is payable to ['PW&S'], together with all bank administration charges incurred by ['PW&S'] as a result of any such late payment, on demand.
- e. Unpaid Cheques: A charge of £15.00 +VAT will be applicable on any represented or unpaid cheques.

5. Delivery

- a. Free delivery for 'DDP' priced wine: minimum of 36 bottles of 750ml or equivalent of value of £450.00 ex VAT required to qualify. (Except Scotland & Inland, delivery price on request)
- b. Free delivery for 'IBD' priced wine in a Costumer bonded warehouse: minimum of 120 bottles of 750ml or equivalent required to qualify. (Except Scotland & Inland, delivery price on request)
- c. If an order is for less than the minimum quantity of wine required to qualify for free delivery as set out in Conditions 5a) and 5b) above, ['PW&S'] shall add a delivery and insurance surcharge to the applicable invoice at its then current delivery/insurance surcharge rate (information on request).

6. Samples

Samples; 1st bottle is a free stock and further sample request will be charged at list price unless agreed. If any order is placed for wines sampled, a credit note will be issued for such sample.

7. Risk and Title

- a. The risk in the wine shall pass to the Customer on delivery of such wine to the Customer.
- b. Notwithstanding delivery and passing of risk, the legal property in and beneficial ownership of the wine shall remain with ['PW&S'] until the Customer has paid all monies owed by it to ['PW&S'].
- c. The Customer grants['PW&S'] an irrevocable licence to enter at any time any vehicles or premises owned or occupied by it for the purpose of repossessing and removing any wine the property in which has remained in ['PW&S'] under condition 7_(b) above.
- d. Until payment is made to ['PW&S'] the Customer shall possess all wine as Bailee only and shall store such wine securely, safely and separately from the Customer's own goods or those of any other person and in a manner which makes them readily identifiable as [PW&S Ltd]'s wine by reference to the relevant invoices supplied by [PW&S Ltd]

8. Liability

- a. [PW&S Ltd] is not be liable to any Customer for defects in wine, shortfalls in quantity delivered, damage or loss in transit unless such Customer notifies [PW&S Ltd] in writing of such defects, shortfall, damage or loss no later than 2 days after delivery of such wine to the Customer.
