PONTE PIETRA

Trebbiano de Soave/Garganega, Veneto, Italy 2015

Lip-smacking green apples and lemony fruit with a hint of freshly baked pastry, this punches well above its weight for the price. Clean and zippy and very, very drinkable. 12.5%

VALENTIN BIANCHI 'FINCA LOS PRIMOS'
Torrontés Mendoza, Argentina, 2015

Torrontés is a rather special grape that really should be more famous and it thrives in this cool-climate part of Mendoza. This wine is seductive as a back-street tango with its gorgeously aromatic nose and beautifully textured richness. A knockout match with spicy food. 13%

BLACK ELEPHANT WINERY
'2 DOGS, A PEACOCK AND A HORSE'
Sauvignon Blanc/Semillion, South Africa 2015

A silly name for a serious wine from this outstanding young winery on the Western Cape. Tip-top Sauvignon Blanc is blended with a little barrel-fermented Semillion to give a bit of extra complexity and richness to this wine that has Old Wine class with New World attitude. 12.9%

GASPER
Chardonnay/Ribolla, Goriška Brda, Slovenia 2015

Oh I say! Fruity but fresh and beautifully rounded, this Chardonnay comes with a Slovenian twist. Ripe fruit is cooled by sea breezes and sings along nicely with a slightly nutty edge. Terrific wine from an interesting region. 13%

BODEGAS CARBALLAL '7 CEPAS'

Albariño, Loureiro, Treixadura, Rias Baixas, Spain 2015

Made in the cool north west of Spain, Albariño is blended with other local grapes in this splendidly distinctive wine. Peachy fruit and zippy acidity with a stony texture and a breathtaking saline twang on the finish. 12%

BODEGA SAN BOAL
Verdejo Castilla y Leon, Spain, 2014

This oft-maligned grape is given a modern twist by looking back to the past when grape juice was fermented with natural yeasts. Named after the patron saint of vines, this has a few days' skin contact and some ageing on the lees giving complexity and depth to this brilliant wine. 13%

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WHITE WINES

VILLA LOCATELLI

Pinot Bianco, Friuli, Italy 2015

From the same family as Pinot Grigio but with just a bit more character and style, this lovely wine has won numerous awards for its fine balance of stone fruit and flowers and elegant mineral finish. 12.5%

TERRAZZE DELL'ETNA 'CIURI'

Nerello Mascalese, Carricante Sicily 2014

The owner of this vineyard is an engineer by profession and his eagle eye for detail shows in his wines. Nerello Mascalese is usually made into red wine but here it makes this astonishing white from the slopes of Mount Etna. Slightly smokey and with a pleasing lick of lava, it's something very special that will reward adventurous drinkers. 12.5%

ESCHENHOF HOLZER 'ALTWEINGARTEN'

Gruner Veltliner, Wagram, Austria 2015

Gruner Veltliner is native to Austria and is having something of a moment. This is from one of the oldest vineyards in the region but is made in a thoroughly modern style by two young brothers who are creating waves in Austria's sometimes-stuffy wine scene. Classic white pepper and blossoms on the nose and a thrilling citrus finish. 12.5%

'SPITFIRE'

Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 2016

This single-vineyard wine from one of the region's stand-out sites gives everything you love about Kiwi Sauv Blancs and so much more. Powerful and bewitching with bags of tropical fruit, incredible bright acidity and a long and lingering finish. We're not at all surprised it won the IWSC Best Sauvignon Blanc Trophy 2016. 14.5%

Reisling, Pfalz, Germany 2015

Rieslings from this region are some of the world's best, and this family have been making wines for five generations so they really know their stuff. Lean and focussed with razor-sharp minerality and a dazzling herbaceous lift. 12%

RED WINES

PONTE PIETRA

Merlot/Corvina Veneto, Italy, 2015

Merlot is one of the world's favourite grapes but can be a little bit heavy and dull. Here Valpolicella's grape Corvina gives lightness and lifted sour cherry fruit in this crackingly good and gluggable wine. 12%

CHATEAU COMBEL-LA-SERRE

'LE PUR FRUIT DU CAUSSE'

Malbec Cahors, France, 2015

Fruity and soft and very, very silky with a very delicious mineral core, this lacks the brutishness of many Malbec's. Very intense but beautifully supple and juicy, this is just the thing on a chilly winter night. 12.5%

CURATOLO ARINI 'PACCAMORA'

Nero D'Avola, Sicily, 2015

Nero D'Avola is native to Sicily and it has a very particular Sicilian swagger. Dark and juicy and full of manly vigour, this has some warming spice with an uplifting freshness. 'Paccamora' means "immediately" and that's just how it should be drunk. 13%

CUATRO PASOS

Mencia Bierzo, Spain, 2013

Rippling with muscles and bursting with fruit, this award-winning wine from Galicia comes from 80-year-old vines and is a great example of modern Spanish winemaking. Morello cherry fruit with a gentle touch of oak, this is full of sexy Spanish verve. 13.5%

PALACIO QUEMADO 'LA ZARCITA'

Tempranillo/Touriga, Nacional Ribera De Guadiana, Spain, 2014

From the river that borders Spain and Portugal, this is a wild and wonderful borderland wine that blends grapes from both countries grown on the plot that gives it its name. If you love Rioja, give this a go. 12%

RED WINES

ESCHENHOF HOLZER

Zweifelt, Wagram, Austria, 2015

This little-known indigenous grape is something of a well-kept secret. It has crunchy red berries and fragrant violets with a bit of black pepper and a captivating mountain freshness. Easy drinking and really refreshing. 12.5%

ALLEGRINI 'PALAZZO DELLA TORRE'

Corvina/Rondinella/Sangiovese, Veneto, Italy, 2013

Fruity and soft and very, very silky with a very delicious mineral core, this lacks the brutishness of many Malbec's. Very intense but beautifully supple and juicy, this is just the thing on a chilly winter night. 13.5%

ZORAH 'KARASI'

Areni Noir Vayots Dzor, Armenia 2013

Made alongside the remains of a winery that dates back more than 6000 years, this extraordinary and unique wine is fermented with natural yeasts and aged in traditional clay amphorae. Complex and voluptuous but with soaring acidity, it's really very thrilling and is incredible value for money. 14%

VALE DE CAPUCHA 'PYNGA'

Syrah/Viognier, Lisbon, Portugal 2012

If you like wines from the northern Rhone, you'll love this rare Portuguese gem. All of Syrah's dark-fruit richness and peppery spice given a lift with a little Viognier, this is smooth but not floppy and has really satisfying length. 14%

TINPOT HUT

Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2014

Ripe dark cherries and juicy plums with aromatic and savoury notes in this Pinot Noir that ticks so many boxes. A touch of oak gives structure while letting the delicate fruit shine through. We spent ages looking for a pitch-perfect pinot and we found it here. 13.5%

DE KLEINE WIJN KOÖP 'KREATUUR NO. 3'

Grenache/Cinsault/Syrah, 2014

Grenache for earthiness, Cinsault for elegance and Syrah for grandeur, this beautiful blend has strawberry-scented fruit along with wafts of wild flowers and just a bit of grunt. 14%

FINCA VILLACRECES 'PRUNO'

Tempranillo / Cabernet Sauvignon, Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2014

A big, ballsy bear hug of a wine from this award-winning winery described by wine critic Robert Parker as "the hidden jewel in Ribera del Duero". Redolent of autumn bonfires, this is swarthy and serious and really, really good. Incredible value for a wine of this class. 14%

GABRIELSKLOOF 'ROSEBUD' Shiraz/Viognier, South Africa 2016

A pretty pink wine made in the Provençal style by Peter-Allan Finalyson, one of South Africa's most revered young winemakers. Melons and papaya dance along with a limey zest and a gentle kiss of spice 12.5%

EL CELLERET BRUT NATURE Penedes, Spain, 2015

Move over Prosecco; Cava is the new fizz on the block. Made by the méthode champenoise, this has elegance as well as freshness and verve and offers fantastic value bubbles for your buck. Viva España! 11.5%

INNOCENT BYSTANDER Moscato, Yarra Valley, Australia, 2015

This is guaranteed to put a smile on the grumpiest of faces. Strawberries, roses and rhubarb in this really delightful slightly sweet fizz. A very jolly aperitif but also great with pastries or pudding. 5.5%

VILLA CIALDINI LAMBRUSCO Lambrusco Grasparossa, Modena, Italy 2015

A world away from the horrid sweet Lambrusco of one's youth, this is made in the traditional way and is a brilliant fizzy red wine for grown ups. Bouncy red fruit with bright and cheering bubbles and a refreshingly dry finish. Try it and be seduced. 11%
