OKLAHOMA CITY –Tennis will once again be a part of the sport listing for The State Games of Oklahoma – 2018 Summer Games. The tournament will be held in Enid, Oklahoma from June 29 – July 1 at the Oakwood Country Club. This marks the first-time a State Games event will be held in the City of Enid.

Matt Lopez and Dwayne Campbell will be the new sport directors for the tournament. “We are excited to offer a change of scenery for participants and welcome everyone to Enid. We can’t wait to host the games and deliver a great tournament experience to all,” Lopez said.

The adult tournament is expected to attract over 100 athletes from across the state to participate in the three-day event. The competition will be open to athletes of all abilities from novice to expert.

The tournament is made possible through a new partnership between The State Games of Oklahoma and the Enid Tennis Association, Oakwood Country Club and the Visit Enid office.
