THE FOLLOWING RULES/REGULATIONS NEED TO BE FOLLOWED. PLEASE REVIEW THEM CAREFULLY.

- Only Westford Academy Class of 2017 may participate.
- Shirts and shoes are required. No costumes or instruments please.
- No food or drinks can be brought into the building. (If you have an allergy, please note this on the permission slip.)
- Once you are checked in, you must remain in the building until 5:00 AM. No one can leave in the morning before the event sponsor deems the event to be over.
- If students register but do not show up for the event, parents will be notified.
- I.D.'s will be distributed and must be worn and visible.
- All belongings will be checked and left in a secure area. Students will have access to their personal belongings at any time throughout the event.
- Doors will be locked at 10:30 PM.
- No alcohol, drugs, smoking or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated and the police officer may administer a breathalyzer test, if deemed necessary.
- If a student is found to be under the influence they will not be allowed to enter the event.

Under certain circumstances a student may be required to leave early due to extenuating circumstances. Although this is discouraged, the following protocol must be adhered to in such cases:

Prior to graduation, if a senior will be picked up early from Last Night, please send an email to info@walastnight.org notifying us that the graduate will be picked up early and the name of the parent or guardian who will be picking them up. Seniors who need to leave the event early must be picked up by a parent or guardian by 1:00 AM. The parent must come in and show their identification. If the senior is not picked up by 1:00 AM, he/she will remain in the building until the event ends.

I have read the rules/regulations of this document and agree to follow them. I understand my (my child's) safety is dependent on my (his/her) own behavior and following the rules listed on this permission slip, as well as any event rules established by the volunteers at Last Night 2017. I agree to be responsible for my own welfare, and accept any and all risks of unanticipated events, illness, or injury to myself that may occur during such participation. It is my intent to release, Westford Academy and the Last Night volunteers from liability relating to any accident and injury sustained by me (my child) or anyone else at Last Night 2017.

For students who will be 18 or older as of June 2, 2017:

I additionally understand that by signing below, I agree and consent that I will not be allowed to leave Last Night 2017 and will remain at the event until the end. If an emergency occurs that requires early dismissal the event sponsor or volunteers will notify my parents that I am leaving.
