Students are taught to a level of mastery using state benchmarks as a tool measuring students' academic growth and development. Gateway of Ohio utilizes a Dropout Prevention and College Preparatory learning model in order to incorporate instruction with our students. Our students in grades 8-12 may enroll in courses earning credits for graduation and that are designed to meet all content standards for the State of Ohio. In addition, Gateway Academy of Ohio offers Career Technical classes in the area of Business Administration that has dual credit attainment with Columbus State Community College.

Our Academic Goals

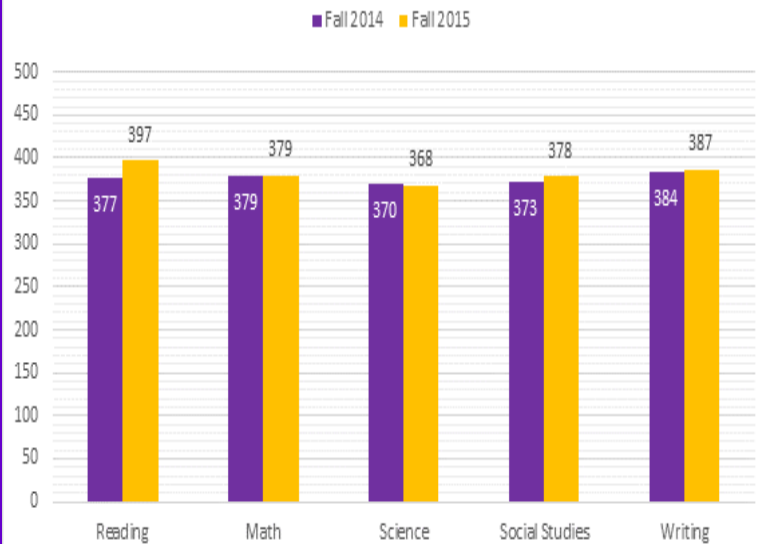

Gateway Academy of Ohio has shown growth from fall 2014 to fall 2015 across the board on the Ohio Graduation Test (OGT).

- ⇒ Writing: 3 point overall increase
- ⇒ Social Studies: 5 point overall increase
- ⇒ Science: 2 point overall increase
- ⇒ Math: maintained the same position
- ⇒ Reading: 20 point overall increase

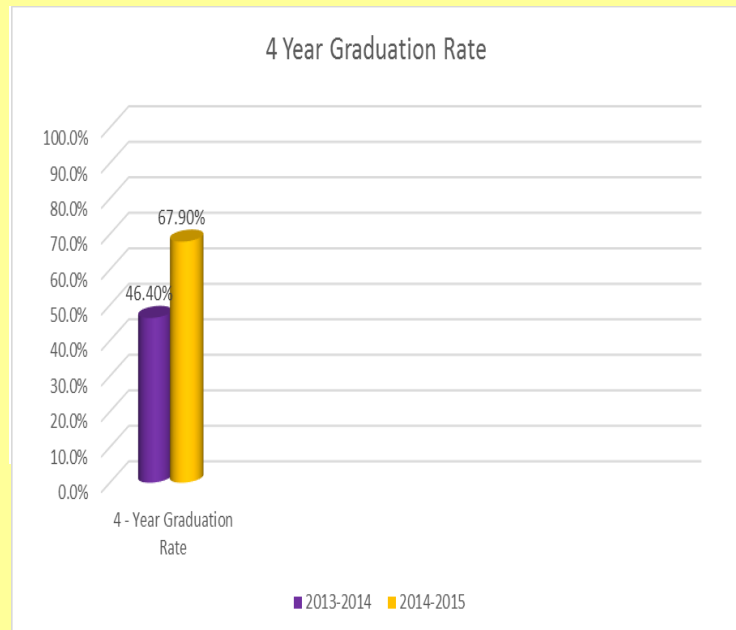
