

**How to Rewind the Doomsday Clock!** The Bulletin of Atomic Scientists, which moved its Doomsday Clock ahead to just two minutes to midnight (Doomsday), offers these steps to rewind the clock: cool Trump rhetoric, negotiate with North Korea, stick with the Iran Deal, reduce U.S.-Russian tensions, and insist on global action on climate change.

In Minnesota, the WAMM Campaign to Ban Nuclear Weapons has collected 10,000 signatures on a petition to demand that the U.S. sign the legally binding international treaty on the prohibition of nuclear weapons. Also: Of the 123 nations that agreed to negotiate the treaty, as of mid-February, 56 nations have signed it and five have actually ratified it: Cuba, Guyana, the Holy See (the Vatican), Mexico, and Guyana. More are expected.
