**Route #2:** Intermediate:  
Snowshoe Route: Matt's Meadow, Lazy Loop & Ridge Run  
Fire & Drink Stop: The Keg Deck, The Sugar Shack

**Route #3:** Intermediate/Advanced:  
Snowshoe Route: True North to the Keg and down Exhibition, Paradise  
Fire & Drink Stop: The Keg Deck, The Sugar Shack
