The Korean name for Lunar New Year's Day, the first day in the Lunar calendar. Seollal is one of the two biggest holidays celebrated in Korea along with chuseok, Korean Thanksgiving.

A Korean tradition where younger people bow to their elders to show respect on seollal. Elders offer well wishes for the new year and give sebae-don (money) in return.



A lucky bag. This colorful, decorative pouch can be tied to the hanbok to carry money or small items.






- 1. Cut along black solid lines.

Tip: Choose between meat and mushroom, or use both!










Let's Make a Paper Bokjumoni 복주머니 만들기




1. Cut a piece of paper into a square, then crease into thirds.




2. Fold both sides of the paper inward to meet each crease.



3. Fold down the top corners.







4. Fold the bottom half up to the top corners.

5. Fold along the dotted line on the left, then unfold to create a triangular crease. Repeat this step on the right.


6. Flip the paper over and fold along both creases in the opposite direction, to create stronger creases.



7. Turn the paper around so it is facing front. You should see diagonal creases now.




8. Pinch the triangle shapes on both sides (where you see X marks) and gently push them inward. The front portion of the paper should lift up.



9. This is how it should look now. Press the sides down to make this shape.

Decorate them and use them!



10. Fold the top over.
